

~PEACEFULLY (26)

[English, quietly, serenely, calmly, manically]

- Joseph's brothers could not bring themselves to speak **peaceably** with him over his dreams.
- When his brothers came to see that their father loved him more than all his brothers, they began to hate him, and they were not able to speak **peacefully** to him. (**Genesis 37:4**)
- The king of Ammon asked Israel to return the land taken from his people centuries earlier, **peacefully**.
- So the king of the sons of Ammon said to the messengers of Jephthah; It is because Israel took my land when they came up out of Egypt, from the Arnon as far as the Jabbok and as far as the Jordan. And now do return it **peacefully**. (**Judges 11:13**)
- Yehowah did **peacefully** pursue his people to walk in the path that they have taken.
- Who kept pursuing them, kept **peacefully** passing along on his feet over the path by which he did not proceed to come? (**Isaiah 41:3**)
