~PEACEFUL (58)

[English, non-violent, passive, diplomatic, Opposite of, violent]

- Israel was to make the men of a city giving them a peaceful answer, into slaves for forced labor, rather than devoting them to destruction.
- And it must occur that if it gives a peaceful answer to you and it has opened up to you, it must even occur that all the people found in it should become yours for forced labor, and they must serve you. (Deuteronomy 20:11)
- Jehospaphat kept peaceful relations with the king of Israel.
- And Jehoshaphat kept peaceful relations with the king of Israel. (1 Kings 22:44)
- The blameless and upright man will have a peaceful future.
- Watch the blameless one and keep the upright one in sight, for the future of that man will be peaceful. (Psalms 37:37)
- All the earth will for a thousand years be at peace. There will be no need for bar or lock, for all men alive will willingly submit to divine principles. They will lie down at night fearing nothing and will sleep undisturbed. No thief will come nor any invading armies, there will be no murderers, rapists nor other criminal elements.
- And my people must dwell in a peaceful abiding place and in residences of full confidence and in undisturbed resting-places. (Isaiah 32:18)
- Their peaceful abiding places, their Churches, Cathedrals, Kingdom Halls and Synagogues will all be rendered lifeless, for their flocks of sheep-like ones will all scatter because of the burning anger of Yehowah.
- And the peaceful abiding places have been rendered lifeless because of the burning anger of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 25:37)

- Like a fruit bearing tree mentioned earlier, we sow these seeds of righteous fruitage not in times of wrath and anger, but under peaceful conditions, and toward those who desire peace with us.
- Moreover, the fruit of righteousness has its seed sown under peaceful conditions for those who are making peace. (James 3:18)
