

## ~REASONABLE (36)

[English, sensible, logical, practical, rational, realistic, level-headed, sound, even handed, equitable, Opposite of, **unreasonable**]

- Paul showed that the Corinthians easily put up with **unreasonable** people because they themselves were **reasonable** people.
- For you gladly put up with the **unreasonable** persons, seeing you are **reasonable**. (2 Corinthians 11:19)
- Paul counseled that overseers should not be given to fighting, but should be **reasonable**.
- Not a drunken brawler, not a smiter, but **reasonable**, not belligerent, not a lover of money. (1 Timothy 3:3)
- To speak injuriously of no one, not to be belligerent, to be **reasonable**, exhibiting all mildness toward all men. (Titus 3:2)
- The wisdom from God is first of all peaceable, then **reasonable**.
- But the wisdom from above is first of all chaste, then peaceable, **reasonable**, ready to obey, full of mercy and good fruits, not making partial distinctions, not hypocritical. (James 3:17)
- House servants should be in subjection no only to those **reasonable** masters but also to those hard to please.
- Let house servants be in subjection to their owners with all due fear, not only to the good and **reasonable**, but also to those hard to please. (1 Peter 2:18)
