

~SHUPPIM 1 (41)
(Shup'pim)

- **A descendant of Benjamin, perhaps through Bela and Iri.**
- **The sons of Benjamin were Bela and Becher and Jediel, three. (1 Chronicles 7:6)**
- **And the sons of Bela were Ezbon and Uzzi and Uzziel and Jerimoth and Iri, five, heads of the house of their forefathers, valiant, mighty men, and their genealogical enrollment was twenty-two thousand and thirty-four. (1 Chronicles 7:7)**
- **And the **Shuppim** and the Huppim were the sons of Ir, the Hushim were the sons of Aher. (1 Chronicles 7:12)**
- **The introduction of **Shuppim** into the genealogies of Manasseh in;**
- **And Machir himself took a wife for Huppim and for **Shuppim**, and the name of his sister was Maacah. And the name of the second was Zelophehad, but Zelophehad came to have daughters. (1 Chronicles 7:15)**
- **May indicate some unusual intertribal relationship. In;**
- **And the sons of Benjamin were Bela and Becher and Ashbel, Gera and Naaman, Ehi and Rosh, **Muppim** and Huppim and Ard. (Genesis 46:21)**
- ****Shuppim** is called **Muppim**, possibly because of the similarity of the letters in the ancient **Hebrew** alphabet represented in **English** by *sh* and *m*. The name is also spelled **Shephupha m, n**, and it identifies the individual as founder of a Benjamite tribal family of **Shuphamites**.**
- **Of **Shephupham** the family of the **Shuphamites**. Of Hupham the family of the Huphamites. (Numbers 26:39)**
- **And Gera and **Shephuphan** and Hiram. (1 Chronicles 8:5)**
