

~SICKNESS ## (119)

[English, illness, disease, virus, bug, condition, bad health, infection]

- And Yehowah will certainly remove from you every **sickness**, and as for all the evil diseases of Egypt that you have known, he will not place them upon you, and he will indeed put them upon all those who hate you. (**Deuteronomy 7:15**)
- Also, any **sickness** and any plague that is not written in the book of this law, Yehowah will bring them upon you until you have been annihilated. (**Deuteronomy 28:61**)
- And it came about after these things that the son of the woman, the mistress of the house, fell sick, and his **sickness** came to be so severe that there was no breath left in him. (**1 Kings 17:17**)
- Then Ahaziah fell down through the grating in his roof chamber that was in Samaria and got sick. So he sent messengers and said to them; Go, inquire of Baal-zebub the god of Ekron whether I shall revive from this **sickness**. (**2 Kings 1:2**)
- At that the king said to Hazael; Take a gift in your hand and go and meet the man of the true God, and you must inquire of Yehowah through him, saying; Shall I revive from this **sickness**? (**2 Kings 8:8**)
- So Hazael went to meet him and took a gift in his hand, even every sort of good thing of Damascus, the load of forty camels, and came and stood before him and said; Your son, Ben-hadad, the king of Syria, has sent me to you, saying; Shall I revive from this **sickness**? (**2 Kings 8:9**)
- As regards Elisha, he had taken sick with the **sickness** with which he was to die. So Jehoash the king of Israel came down to him and began to weep over his face and say; My father, my father, the war chariot of Israel and his horsemen! (**2 Kings 13:14**)
- And Asa in the thirty-ninth year of his reign developed an ailment in his feet until he was very sick, and even in his **sickness** he searched not for Yehowah but for the healers. (**2 Chronicles 16:12**)

- And you will be with many **sicknesses**, with a malady of your intestines, until your intestines have come out because of the sickness day by day. (**2 Chronicles 21:15**)
- And after all this Yehowah plagued him in his intestines with a **sickness** for which there was no healing. (**2 Chronicles 21:18**)
- And it came about that in the days to come, even when the term of two full years had expired, his intestines came out during his **sickness**, and he gradually died in his bad maladies, and his people did not make a burning for him like the burning for his forefathers. (**2 Chronicles 21:19**)
- Yehowah himself will sustain him upon a divan of illness, all his bed you will certainly change during his **sickness**. (**Psalms 41:3**)
- Also, all his days he eats in darkness itself, with a great deal of vexation, with **sickness** on his part and cause for indignation. (**Ecclesiastes 5:17**)
- A man to whom the true God gives riches and material possessions and glory and who, for his soul, is in no need of anything that he shows himself longing for, and yet the true God does not enable him to eat from it, although a mere foreigner may eat it. This is vanity and it is a bad **sickness**. (**Ecclesiastes 6:2**)
- He was despised and was avoided by men, a man meant for pains and for having acquaintance with **sickness**. And there was as if the concealing of ones face from us. He was despised, and we held him as of no account. (**Isaiah 53:3**)
- As a cistern keeps its waters cool, so she has kept her badness cool. Violence and despoiling are heard in her, **sickness** and plague are before my face constantly. (**Jeremiah 6:7**)
- Woe to me on account of my breakdown! My stroke has become sickish. And I myself have said, Surely this is my **sickness**, and I shall carry it. (**Jeremiah 10:19**)
- And Ephraim got to see his **sickness**, and Judah his ulcer. And Ephraim proceeded to go to Assyria and send to a great king. But that one himself was unable to give healing to you people, and he could not take from you an ulcer with any cure. (**Hosea 5:13**)

- **And immediately her fountain of blood dried up, and she sensed in her body that she had been healed of the grievous **sickness**. (Mark 5:29)**
- **He said to her; Daughter, your faith has made you well. Go in peace, and be in good health from your grievous **sickness**. (Mark 5:34)**
- **But a certain man was there who had been in his **sickness** for thirty-eight years. (John 5:5)**
- **But when Jesus heard it he said; This **sickness** is not with death as its object, but is for the glory of God, in order, that the Son of God may be glorified through it. (John 11:4)**
- **But you know that it was through a **sickness** of my flesh I declared the Good News to you the first time. (Galatians 4:13)**
- **Do not drink water any longer, but use a little wine for the sake of your stomach and your frequent cases of **sickness**. (1 Timothy 5:23)**
