

**~SIN (41)**  
**(Shin)**

- The 21st letter in the **Hebrew** alphabet. This letter was used to represent two sounds, and in later periods, these were distinguished by the use of a diacritical mark.
- A dot placed over the left-hand **horn** gave the pronunciation *s*, while a dot placed over the right-hand **horn** gave the pronunciation *sh*.
- In the **Hebrew**, each of the eight verses of;
- Princes themselves have persecuted me for no cause, but my heart has been in dread of your own words. (**Psalms 119:161**)
- I am exulting over your saying just as one does when finding much spoil. (**Psalms 119:162**)
- Falsehood I have hated, and I do keep detesting it. Your Law I have loved. (**Psalms 119:163**)
- Seven times in the day I have praised you because of your righteous judicial decisions. (**Psalms 119:164**)
- Abundant peace belongs to those loving your Law, and for them there is no stumbling block. (**Psalms 119:165**)
- I have hoped for your salvation, O Yehowah, and I have done your own commandments. (**Psalms 119:166**)
- My soul has kept your reminders, and I love them exceedingly. (**Psalms 119:167**)
- I have kept your orders and your reminders, for all my ways are in front of you. (**Psalms 119:168**)
