- And she was a widow now eighty-four years old, who was never missing from the temple, rendering sacred service night and day with fastings and **supplications**. (Luke 2:37)
- They said to him; The disciples of John fast frequently and offer **supplications**, and so do those of the Pharisees, but yours eat and drink. (Luke 5:33)
- While night and day we make more than extraordinary **supplications** to see your faces and to make good the things that are lacking about your faith? (1 Thessalonians 3:10)
- I therefore exhort, first of all, that **supplications**, prayers, intercessions, offerings of thanks, be made concerning all sorts of men. (1 Timothy 2:1)
- Now the woman who is actually a widow and left destitute has put her hope in God and persists in **supplications** and prayers night and day. (1 Timothy 5:5)
- I am grateful to God, to whom I am rendering sacred service as my forefathers did and with a clean conscience, that I never leave off remembering you in my **supplications**, night and day. (2 Timothy 1:3)
