

~ Anointed (78)

Genesis 31:13,, I am the true God of Bethel where you anointed a pillar and where you vowed a vow to me Now get up go out of this land and return to the land of your birth

Exodus 40:15,, And you must anoint them just as you anointed their father and so they must act as priests to me and their anointing must serve continually for them as a priesthood to time indefinite during their generations

Leviticus 4:3,, If the priest the anointed one sins so as to bring guiltiness upon the people then he must present for his sin that he has committed a sound young bull to Yehowah as a sin offering

Leviticus 4:5, And the priest the anointed one must take some of the bull's blood and bring it into the tent of meeting

Leviticus 4:16, Then the priest the anointed one must bring some of the bull's blood into the tent of meeting

Leviticus 6:20, This is the offering of Aaron and his sons that they will present to Yehowah on the day of his being anointed the tenth of an ephah of fine flour as a grain offering constantly half of it in the morning and half of it in the evening

Leviticus 6:22, And the priest the one anointed in place of him from among his sons will make it It is a regulation to time indefinite As a whole offering it will be made to smoke to Yehowah

Leviticus 8:10, Moses now took the anointing oil and anointed the tabernacle and all that was in it and sanctified them

Leviticus 8:11. **After that he spattered some of it seven times upon the altar and anointed the altar and all its utensils and the basin and its stand so as to sanctify them**

Leviticus 8:12. **Finally he poured some of the anointing oil upon Aaron's head and anointed him so as to sanctify him**

Leviticus 16:32. **And the priest who will be anointed and whose hand will be filled with power to act as priest as successor of his father must make an atonement and must put on the linen garments They are holy garments**

Numbers 3:3.. **These were the names of Aaron's sons the anointed priests whose hands had been filled with power to act as priests**

Numbers 7:1. **Now it came about on the day that Moses finished setting up the tabernacle that he proceeded to anoint it and to sanctify it and all its furnishings and the altar and all its utensils Thus he anointed them and sanctified them**

Numbers 7:10. **Now the chieftains made their presentation at the inauguration of the altar on the day of its being anointed and the chieftains proceeded with presenting their offering before the altar**

Numbers 7:84. **This was the inauguration offering of the altar on the day of its being anointed on the part of the chieftains of Israel twelve silver dishes twelve silver bowls twelve gold cups**

Numbers 7:88. **and all the cattle of the communion sacrifice being twenty-four bulls sixty rams sixty he-goats sixty male lambs each a year old This was the inauguration offering of the altar after its being anointed**

Numbers 35:25. **And the assembly must deliver the manslayer out of the hand of the avenger of blood and the assembly must return him to his city of refuge to which he had fled and he must dwell in it**

until the death of the **high priest who was anointed with the holy oil**

1 Samuel 2:10.. As for Yehowah those contending against him will be terrified Against them he will thunder in the heavens Yehowah himself will judge the ends of the earth that he may give strength to his king that he may exalt **the horn of his anointed one**

1 Samuel 2:35. And I shall certainly raise up for myself a faithful priest In harmony with what is in my heart and in my soul he will do and I shall certainly build for him a lasting house and he will **certainly walk before my anointed one always**

1 Samuel 10:1. Samuel then took the flask of oil and poured it out upon his head and kissed him and said Is it **not because Yehowah has anointed you as a leader** over his inheritance

1 Samuel 12:3. Here I am Answer against me in front of Yehowah and **in front of his anointed one Whose bull have I taken or whose ass have I taken or whom have I defrauded or whom have I crushed or from whose hand have I accepted hush money that I should hide my eyes with it And I shall make restoration to YOU people**

1 Samuel 12:5. So he said to them Yehowah is a witness **against YOU and his anointed one is a witness** this day that YOU have found nothing at all in my hand To this they said He is a witness

1 Samuel 16:6. And it came about that as they came in and he caught sight of Eliab he at **once said Surely his anointed one is before Yehowah**

1 Samuel 16:13. Accordingly Samuel took the **horn of oil and anointed him in the midst** of his brothers And the spirit of Yehowah began to be operative upon David from that day forward Later Samuel rose and went his way to Ramah

- 1 Samuel 24:6. Hence he said to his men It is unthinkable on my part from Yehowah's standpoint that I should do this thing **to my lord the anointed of Yehowah by thrusting** out my hand against him for he is the anointed of Yehowah
- 1 Samuel 24:10. Here this day your eyes have seen how Yehowah gave you today into my hand in the cave and someone said to kill you but I felt sorry for you and said I shall not thrust out my hand against my lord **for he is the anointed of Yehowah**
- 1 Samuel 26:9. However David said to Abishai Do not bring him to ruin for who is it that has thrust his **hand out against the anointed of Yehowah and has** remained innocent
- 1 Samuel 26:11. It is unthinkable on my part from Yehowah's standpoint to thrust my **hand out against the anointed of Yehowah** So now take please the spear that is at his head and the water jug and let us get on our way
- 1 Samuel 26:16. This thing that you have done is not good As Yehowah is living **YOU men deserve to die because YOU have not watched over YOUR lord over the anointed of Yehowah** And now see where the king's spear and the water jug are that were at his head
- 1 Samuel 26:23. And Yehowah it is who will repay to each one his own righteousness and his own faithfulness in that Yehowah today gave you into my hand and I was unwilling to thrust my **hand out against the anointed of Yehowah**
- 2 Samuel 1:14.. Then David said to him How was it that you did not fear to thrust your hand **out to bring the anointed of Yehowah to ruin**
- 2 Samuel 1:16. David then said to him The bloodguilt for you be upon your own head because your own mouth has testified against you saying I **myself definitely put the anointed of Yehowah to death**

- 2 Samuel 1:21. **YOU mountains of Gilboa let no dew let no rain be upon YOU nor let there be fields of holy contributions because there the shield of mighty ones was befouled the shield of Saul so that there was none anointed with oil**
- 2 Samuel 2:4. **Then the men of Judah came and anointed David there as king over the house of Judah And they came telling David saying The men of Jabesh-gilead were the ones that buried Saul**
- 2 Samuel 2:7. **And now let YOUR hands strengthen themselves and prove yourselves valiant men because YOUR lord Saul is dead and it is even I whom the house of Judah have anointed as king over them**
- 2 Samuel 3:39. **And I today am weak although anointed as king and these men the sons of Zeruiah are too severe for me May Yehowah repay the doer of what is bad according to his own badness**
- 2 Samuel 5:3. **So all the older men of Israel came to the king at Hebron and King David concluded a covenant with them in Hebron before Yehowah after which they anointed David as king over Israel**
- 2 Samuel 5:17. **And the Philistines got to hear that they had anointed David as king over Israel At that all the Philistines came up to look for David When David heard of it then he went down to the place hard to approach**
- 2 Samuel 12:7. **Then Nathan said to David You yourself are the man This is what Yehowah the God of Israel has said I myself anointed you as king over Israel and I myself delivered you out of the hand of Saul**
- 2 Samuel 19:10. **As for Absalom whom we anointed over us he has died in the battle So now why are YOU doing nothing to bring the king back**

2 Samuel 19:21. **At once Abishai the son of Zeruiah answered and said In return for this should not Shimei be put to death in that he called evil down upon the anointed of Yehowah**

2 Samuel 22:51. **The One doing great acts of salvation for his king and exercising loving-kindness to his anointed one to David and to his seed for time indefinite**

2 Samuel 23:1. **And these are the last words of David The utterance of David the son of Jesse and the utterance of the able-bodied man that was raised up on high the anointed of the God of Jacob and the pleasant one of the melodies of Israel**

1 Kings 1:39. **Zadok the priest now took the horn of oil out of the tent and anointed Solomon and they began to blow the horn and all the people broke out saying Let King Solomon live**

1 Kings 1:45. **Then Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet anointed him as king in Gihon after which they came up from there rejoicing and the town is in an uproar That was the noise that YOU men heard**

1 Kings 5:1. **And Hiram the king of Tyre proceeded to send his servants to Solomon for he had heard that it was he that they had anointed as king in place of his father for a lover of David Hiram had always proved to be**

2 Kings 11:12. **Then he brought the son of the king out and put upon him the diadem and the Testimony and so they made him king and anointed him And they began to clap their hands and say Let the king live**

2 Kings 23:30. **So his servants conveyed him dead in a chariot from Megiddo and brought him to Jerusalem and buried him in his grave Then the people of the land took Jehoahaz the son of Josiah and anointed him and made him king in place of his father**

- 1 Chronicles 11:3,,** So all the older men of Israel came to the king at Hebron and David concluded a covenant with them in Hebron before **Yehowah** after which they **anointed** David as king over Israel according to Yehowah's word by means of Samuel
- 1 Chronicles 14:8,** And the Philistines got to hear **that David had been anointed as king over all** Israel At that all the Philistines came up to look for David When David heard of it then he went out against them
- 1 Chronicles 16:22,** Saying Do not **YOU men touch my anointed ones and to my** prophets do nothing bad
- 2 Chronicles 6:42,,** O Yehowah God do not turn back **the face of your anointed one** O do remember the loving-kindnesses to David your servant
- 2 Chronicles 22:7,** But it was from God that the downfall of Ahaziah occurred by his coming to Jehoram and when he came he went out with Jehoram to Jehu the grandson of **Nimshi whom Yehowah had anointed to cut off the** house of Ahab
- 2 Chronicles 23:11,** Then they brought the king's son out and put upon him the diadem and the Testimony and made him king and so **Jehoiada and his sons anointed him and said** Let the king live
- Psalms 2:2,,** The kings of earth take their stand and high officials themselves have massed together as one against **Yehowah and against his anointed one**
- Psalms 18:50,** He is doing great acts of salvation for his king and exercising loving-kindness to his **anointed one to David and to his seed to time indefinite**
- Psalms 20:6,** Now I do know that **Yehowah certainly saves his anointed one** He answers him from his holy heavens with the saving mighty acts of his right hand

Psalms 28:8. Yehowah is a strength to his people and he is a stronghold of the **grand salvation of his anointed one**

Psalms 45:7. You have loved righteousness and you hate wickedness That is why **God your God has anointed you with the oil of exultation more than your partners**

Psalms 84:9. O shield of ours see O God and look upon **the face of your anointed one**

Psalms 89:20. I have found David my servant with my **holy oil I have anointed him**

Psalms 89:38. But you you have cast off and you keep contemning you have **become furious toward your anointed one**

Psalms 89:51. How your enemies have reproached O Yehowah how they have reproached **the footprints of your anointed one**

Psalms 105:15. Saying Do not **YOU men touch my anointed ones and to my prophets do nothing bad**

Psalms 132:10. On account of David your servant do not turn back **the face of your anointed one**

Psalms 132:17. There I shall cause the horn of David to grow I have set in order **a lamp for my anointed one**

Isaiah 45:1 This is what Yehowah **has said to his anointed one to Cyrus whose** right hand I have taken hold of to subdue before him nations so that I may ungird even the hips of kings to open before him the two-leaved doors so that even the gates will not be shut

Isaiah 61:1 The spirit of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah is upon me for the **reason that Yehowah has anointed me to tell good news to the meek ones** He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted to

proclaim liberty to those taken captive and the wide opening of the eyes even to the prisoners

Lamentations 4:20.. The very breath of our nostrils the **anointed one of Yehowah** has been captured in their large pit The one of whom we have said In his shade we shall live among the nations

Ezekiel 28:14.. You are the **anointed cherub that is covering** and I have set you On the holy mountain of God you proved to be In the midst of fiery stones you walked about

Habakkuk 3:13.. And you went forth for the salvation of your people to save your **anointed one** You broke to pieces the head one out of the house of the wicked one There was a laying of the foundation bare clear up to the neck Selah

Zechariah 4:14.. Accordingly he said **These are the two anointed ones who are standing** alongside the Lord of the whole earth

Luke 4:18.. Yehowah's spirit is upon me because he **anointed me to declare good** news to the poor he sent me forth to preach a release to the captives and a recovery of sight to the blind to send the crushed ones away with a release

Acts of Apostles 4:26.. The kings of the earth took their stand and the rulers massed together as one against **Yehowah and against his anointed one**

Acts of Apostles 4:27. Even so both Herod and Pontius Pilate with men of nations and with peoples of Israel were in actuality gathered together in this city against your **holy servant Jesus whom you anointed**

Acts of Apostles 10:38. namely Jesus who was from Nazareth how God **anointed him with holy spirit** and power and he went through the land doing good and healing all those oppressed by the Devil because God was with him

2 Corinthians 1:21..

But he who guarantees that YOU and we belong to Christ and he who has anointed us is God

Hebrews 1:9..

You loved righteousness and you hated lawlessness That is why God your God anointed you with the oil of exultation more than your partners
