

~ Naomi (19)

- Ruth 1:2..** And the man's name was Elimelech and his wife's name **Naomi** and the names of his two sons were Mahlon and Chilion Ephrathites from Bethlehem in Judah Eventually they came to the fields of Moab and continued there
- Ruth 1:3.** In time **Elimelech the husband of Naomi** died so that she remained with her two sons
- Ruth 1:8.** Finally **Naomi** said to both of her daughters-in-law Go return each one to the house of her mother May Yehowah exercise loving-kindness toward YOU just as YOU have exercised it toward the men now dead and toward me
- Ruth 1:11.** But **Naomi** said Return my daughters Why should YOU go with me Do I still have sons in my inward parts and will they have to become YOUR husbands
- Ruth 1:19.** And they both continued on their way until they came to Bethlehem And it came about that as soon as they came to Bethlehem all the city became stirred up over them and the women kept saying Is this **Naomi**
- Ruth 1:20.** And she would say to the women Do not call me **Naomi** Call me **Mara** for the Almighty has made it very bitter for me
- Ruth 1:21.** I was full when I went and it is empty-handed that Yehowah has made me return Why should YOU call me **Naomi** when it is Yehowah that has humiliated me and the Almighty that has caused me calamity
- Ruth 1:22.** Thus **Naomi** made her return **Ruth** the Moabite woman her daughter-in-law being with her when returning from the fields of

Moab and they came to Bethlehem at the commencement of barley harvest

Ruth 2:1. **Now Naomi had a kinsman of her husband a man mighty in wealth of the family of Elimelech and his name was Boaz**

Ruth 2:2. **In time Ruth the Moabite woman said to Naomi Let me go please to the field and glean among the ears of grain following after whoever it is in whose eyes I may find favor So she said to her Go my daughter**

Ruth 2:6. **So the young man set over the harvesters answered and said The young woman is a Moabitess who returned with Naomi from the field of Moab**

Ruth 2:20. **At that Naomi said to her daughter-in-law Blessed be he of Yehowah who has not left his loving-kindness toward the living and the dead And Naomi went on to say to her The man is related to us He is one of our repurchasers**

Ruth 2:22. **So Naomi said to Ruth her daughter-in-law It is better my daughter that you should go out with his young women that they may not annoy you in another field**

Ruth 3:1. **Naomi her mother-in-law now said to her My daughter ought I not to look for a resting-place for you that it may go well with you**

Ruth 4:3. **He now said to the repurchaser The tract of the field that belonged to our brother Elimelech Naomi who has returned from the field of Moab must sell**

Ruth 4:9. **Then Boaz said to the older men and all the people YOU are witnesses today that I do buy all that belonged to Elimelech and all that belonged to Chilion and Mahlon from the hand of Naomi**

Ruth 4:14. **And the women began to say to Naomi Blessed be Yehowah who has not let a repurchaser fail for you today that his name may be proclaimed in Israel**

Ruth 4:16. **And Naomi proceeded to take the child and to put it in her bosom and she came to be its nurse**

Ruth 4:17. **Then the neighbor ladies gave it a name saying A son has been born to Naomi And they began to call his name Obed He is the father of Jesse David's father**
