

**~ Nebuchadnezzar (55) `**

**2 Kings 24:1**· **In his days Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** came up and so Jehoiakim became his servant for three years However he turned back and rebelled against him

**2 Kings 24:10**· **During that time the servants of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** came up to Jerusalem so that the city came under siege

**2 Kings 24:11**· **And Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** proceeded to come against the city while his servants were laying siege against it

**2 Kings 25:1**· **And it came about in the ninth year of his being king in the tenth month on the tenth day of the month that Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** came yes he and all his military force against Jerusalem and began camping against it and building against it a siege wall all around

**2 Kings 25:8**· **And in the fifth month on the seventh day of the month that is to say the nineteenth year of King Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** Nebuzaradan the chief of the bodyguard the servant of the king of Babylon came to Jerusalem

**2 Kings 25:22**· **As for the people left behind in the land of Judah whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** had left behind he now appointed over them Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan

**1 Chronicles 6:15**· **And Jehozadak it was that went away when Yehowah took Judah and Jerusalem into exile by the hand of Nebuchadnezzar**

- 2 Chronicles 36:6..**      **Against him Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon came up that he might bind him with two fetters of copper to carry him off to Babylon**
- 2 Chronicles 36:7.**      **And some of the utensils of the house of Yehowah Nebuchadnezzar brought to Babylon and then put them in his palace in Babylon**
- 2 Chronicles 36:10.**      **And at the return of the year King Nebuchadnezzar sent and proceeded to bring him to Babylon with desirable articles of the house of Yehowah Further he made Zedekiah his father's brother king over Judah and Jerusalem**
- 2 Chronicles 36:13.**      **And even against King Nebuchadnezzar he rebelled who had made him swear by God and he kept stiffening his neck and hardening his heart so as not to return to Yehowah the God of Israel**
- Ezra 1:7..**      **Also King Cyrus himself brought forth the utensils of the house of Yehowah which Nebuchadnezzar had brought out from Jerusalem and then put in the house of his god**
- Ezra 2:1.**      **And these were the sons of the jurisdictional district that went up out of the captivity of the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon had taken into exile at Babylon and who later returned to Jerusalem and Judah each one to his own city**
- Ezra 5:12.**      **However because our fathers irritated the God of the heavens he gave them into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon the Chaldean and he demolished this house and took the people into exile at Babylon**
- Ezra 5:14.**      **And also the gold and silver vessels of the house of God that Nebuchadnezzar had taken out of the temple which was in Jerusalem and brought to the temple of Babylon these Cyrus the king took out of the temple of Babylon and they were given to Sheshbazzar the name of the one whom he made governor**

**Ezra 6:5.** And also let the gold and silver vessels of the **house of God** that **Nebuchadnezzar** took out of the temple that was in Jerusalem and brought to Babylon be returned that they may reach the temple that is in Jerusalem at its place and be deposited in the house of God

**Nehemiah 7:6..** These are the sons of the jurisdictional district who came up out of the captivity of **the exiled people whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** had taken into exile and who later returned to Jerusalem and to Judah each to his own city

**Esther 2:6..** who had been taken into exile from Jerusalem with the deported people who were taken into exile with Jeconiah the **king of Judah whom Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** took into exile

**Jeremiah 27:6..** And now I myself have given all these lands **into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** my servant and even the wild beasts of the field I have given him to serve him

**Jeremiah 27:8.** And it must occur that the nation and the kingdom that will **not serve him even Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** and the one that will not put its neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon with the sword and with the famine and with the pestilence I shall turn my attention upon that nation' is the utterance of Yehowah until I shall have finished them off by his hand

**Jeremiah 27:20.** that **Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** had not taken when he carried Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim the king of Judah into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon together with all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem

**Jeremiah 28:3.** Within two full years more I am bringing back to this place all the utensils of the **house of Yehowah that Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon** took from this place that he might bring them to Babylon

Jeremiah 28:11. **And Hananiah went on to say before the eyes of all the people This is what Yehowah has said Just like this I shall break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon within two full years more from off the neck of all the nations And Jeremiah the prophet proceeded to go his way**

Jeremiah 28:14. **For this is what Yehowah of armies the God of Israel has said A yoke of iron I will put upon the neck of all these nations to serve Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon and they must serve him And even the wild beasts of the field I will give him**

Jeremiah 29:1. **And these are the words of the letter that Jeremiah the prophet sent from Jerusalem to the remainder of the older men of the exiled people and to the priests and to the prophets and to all the people whom Nebuchadnezzar had carried into exile from Jerusalem to Babylon**

Jeremiah 29:3. **It was by the hand of Elasah the son of Shaphan and Gemariah the son of Hilkiyah whom Zedekiah the king of Judah sent to Babylon to Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon saying:**

Daniel 1:1. **In the third year of the kingship of Jehoiakim the king of Judah Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon came to Jerusalem and proceeded to lay siege to it**

Daniel 1:18. **And at the end of the days that the king had said to bring them in the principal court official also proceeded to bring them in before Nebuchadnezzar**

Daniel 2:1. **And in the second year of the kingship of Nebuchadnezzar Nebuchadnezzar dreamed dreams and his spirit began to feel agitated and his very sleep was made to be something beyond him**

Daniel 2:28. **However there exists a God in the heavens who is a Revealer of secrets and he has made known to King Nebuchadnezzar what is to occur in the final part of the days Your dream and the visions of your head upon your bed this it is:**

Daniel 2:46. **At that time King Nebuchadnezzar himself fell down upon his face and to Daniel he paid homage and he said to offer even a present and incense to him**

Daniel 3:1. **Nebuchadnezzar the king made an image of gold the height of which was sixty cubits and the breadth of which was six cubits He set it up in the plain of Dura in the jurisdictional district of Babylon**

Daniel 3:2. **And Nebuchadnezzar himself as king sent to assemble the satraps the prefects and the governors the counselors the treasurers the judges the police magistrates and all the administrators of the jurisdictional districts to come to the inauguration of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up**

Daniel 3:3. **At that time the satraps the prefects and the governors the counselors the treasurers the judges the police magistrates and all the administrators of the jurisdictional districts were assembling themselves for the inauguration of the image that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up and they were standing in front of the image that Nebuchadnezzar had set up**

Daniel 3:5. **that at the time that YOU hear the sound of the horn the pipe the zither the triangular harp the stringed instrument the bagpipe and all sorts of musical instruments YOU fall down and worship the image of gold that Nebuchadnezzar the king has set up**

Daniel 3:7. **Because of this at the same time as all the peoples were hearing the sound of the horn the pipe the zither the triangular harp the stringed instrument and all sorts of musical instruments all the peoples national groups and languages were falling down and worshipping the image of gold that Nebuchadnezzar the king had set up**

Daniel 3:9. **They answered and they were saying to Nebuchadnezzar the king O king live on even for times indefinite**

- Daniel 3:13. **At that time Nebuchadnezzar in a rage and fury said to bring in Shadrach Meshach and Abednego** Consequently these able-bodied men were brought in before the king
- Daniel 3:14. **Nebuchadnezzar was answering and saying to them** Is it really so O Shadrach Meshach and Abednego that YOU are not serving my own gods and the image of gold that I have set up YOU are not worshipping
- Daniel 3:16. **Shadrach Meshach and Abednego answered and they were saying to the king O Nebuchadnezzar we are under no necessity in this regard to say back a word to you**
- Daniel 3:19. **Then it was that Nebuchadnezzar himself got filled with fury and the very expression of his face was changed toward Shadrach Meshach and Abednego** He was answering and saying to heat up the furnace seven times more than it was customary to heat it up
- Daniel 3:24. **At that time Nebuchadnezzar the king himself became frightened and he rose up in a hurry** He was answering and saying to his high royal officials Was it not three able-bodied men that we threw bound into the midst of the fire They were answering and saying to the king Yes O king
- Daniel 3:26. **Then it was that Nebuchadnezzar approached the door of the burning fiery furnace** He was answering and saying Shadrach Meshach and Abednego YOU servants of the Most High God step out and come here At that time Shadrach Meshach and Abednego were stepping out from the midst of the fire
- Daniel 3:28. **Nebuchadnezzar was answering and saying** Blessed be the God of Shadrach Meshach and Abednego who sent his angel and rescued his servants that trusted in him and that changed the very word of the king and gave over their bodies because they would not serve and would not worship any god at all except their own God

- Daniel 4:1. **Nebuchadnezzar the king to all the peoples national groups and languages that are dwelling in all the earth May YOUR peace grow great**
- Daniel 4:4. **I Nebuchadnezzar happened to be at ease in my house and flourishing in my palace**
- Daniel 4:18. **This was the dream that I myself King Nebuchadnezzar beheld and you yourself O Belteshazzar say what the interpretation is forasmuch as all the other wise men of my kingdom are unable to make known to me the interpretation itself But you are competent because the spirit of holy gods is in you**
- Daniel 4:28. **All this befell Nebuchadnezzar the king**
- Daniel 4:31. **While the word was yet in the king's mouth there was a voice that fell from the heavens To you it is being said O Nebuchadnezzar the king The kingdom itself has gone away from you**
- Daniel 4:33. **At that moment the word itself was fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar and from mankind he was being driven away and vegetation he began to eat just like bulls and with the dew of the heavens his own body got to be wet until his very hair grew long just like eagles' feathers and his nails like birds' claws**
- Daniel 4:34. **And at the end of the days I Nebuchadnezzar lifted up to the heavens my eyes and my own understanding began to return to me and I blessed the Most High himself and the One living to time indefinite I praised and glorified because his rulership is a rulership to time indefinite and his kingdom is for generation after generation**
- Daniel 4:37. **Now I Nebuchadnezzar am praising and exalting and glorifying the King of the heavens because all his works are tRuth and his ways are justice and because those who are walking in pride he is able to humiliate**

Daniel 5:2. **Belshazzar under the influence of the wine said to bring in the vessels of gold and of silver that Nebuchadnezzar his father had taken away from the temple that was in Jerusalem that from them the king and his grandees his concubines and his secondary wives might drink**

Daniel 5:11. **There exists a capable man in your kingdom in whom there is the spirit of holy gods and in the days of your father illumination and insight and wisdom like the wisdom of gods were found in him and King Nebuchadnezzar your father himself set him up as chief of the magic-practicing priests the conjurers the Chaldeans and the astrologers even your father O king**

Daniel 5:18. **As for you O king the Most High God himself gave to Nebuchadnezzar your father the kingdom and the greatness and the dignity and the majesty**
