

Ecclesiastes 10:17 Happy are you, O land, when your king is the son of noble ones and your own princes eat at the proper time for mightiness, not for mere drinking.

[6] - References:

- It is not for **kings**, O Lemuel, it is not for **kings** to drink wine or for high officials to say; Where is intoxicating liquor? (**Proverbs 31:4**)
- And these also, because of wine they have gone astray and because of intoxicating liquor they have wandered about. Priest and prophet, they have gone astray because of intoxicating liquor, they have become confused as a result of the wine, they have wandered about as a result of the intoxicating liquor, they have gone astray in their seeing, they have reeled as to decision. (**Isaiah 28:7**)
- On the day of our **king**, **princes** have sickened themselves, there is a rage because of wine. He has drawn his hand along with deriders. (**Hosea 7:5**)
- And they began to go out at noon while Ben-hadad was **drinking** himself drunk in the booths, he together with the **kings**, the thirty-two **kings** that were helping him. (**1 Kings 20:16**)
- Then he brought the **son** of the **king** out and put upon him the diadem and the Testimony, and so they made him **king** and anointed him. And they began to clap their hands and say; Let the **king** live! (**2 Kings 11:12**)
- For a drunkard and a glutton will come to poverty, and drowsiness will clothe one with **mere** rags. (**Proverbs 23:21**)
