[7] - References:

- The wicked one is borrowing and does not pay back, but the righteous one is showing favor and is making gifts. (**Psalms 37:21**)
- Practice giving, and people **will** give to **YOU**. They **will** pour into **YOUR** laps a fine measure, pressed down, shaken together and overflowing. For with the measure that **YOU** are measuring out, they **will** measure out to **YOU** in return. (**Luke 6:38**)
- Moreover, the multitude of those who had believed had one heart and soul, and not **even** one would say that any of the things he possessed was his own, but they had all things in common. (**Acts of Apostles 4:32**)
- Let each one do just as he has resolved in his heart, not grudgingly or under compulsion, for God loves a cheerful giver. (**2 Corinthians 9:7**)
- To work at good, to be rich in fine works, to be liberal, ready to share. (**1 Timothy 6:18**)
- Therefore, O king, may my counsel seem good to you, and remove your own sins by righteousness, and your iniquity by showing mercy to the poor ones. Maybe there **will occur** a lengthening of your prosperity. (**Daniel 4:27**)
- He has distributed widely, he has given to the poor ones. His righteousness is standing forever. His own horn **will** be exalted with glory. (**Psalms 112:9**)
