[7] - References:

- All that your **hand** finds to do, do with your very power, for there is no work nor devising nor knowledge nor wisdom in Sheol, the place to which you are going. (**Ecclesiastes 9:10**)
- Sow **seed** for yourselves in righteousness, reap in accord with loving-kindness. Till for yourselves arable land, when there is time for searching for Yehowah **until** he comes and gives instruction in righteousness to **you**. (**Hosea 10:12**)
- We must work the works of him that sent me while it is day, the night is coming when no man can work. (**John 9:4**)
- But as to this, he that **sows** sparingly **will** also reap sparingly, and he that **sows** bountifully **will** also reap bountifully. (**2 Corinthians 9:6**)
- Whatever **you** are doing, work at it whole-souled as to Yehowah, and not to men. (**Colossians 3:23**)
- Do not make your boast about the next day, for you do not know what a day **will** give birth to. (**Proverbs 27:1**)
- Whereas **you** do not know what **your** life **will** be tomorrow. For **you** are a mist appearing for a little while and then disappearing. (**James 4:14**)
