In the morning sow your seed and until the evening do not let your hand rest, for you are not knowing where this will have success, either here or there, or whether both of them will alike be good.

- All that your hand finds to do, do with your very power, for there is no work nor devising nor knowledge nor wisdom in Sheol, the place to which you are going. (Ecclesiastes 9:10)
- Sow seed for yourselves in righteousness, reap in accord with loving-kindness. Till for yourselves arable land, when there is time for searching for Yehowah until he comes and gives instruction in righteousness to you. (Hosea 10:12)

- But as to this, he that sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he that sows bountifully will also reap bountifully. (2 Corinthians 9:6)
