For the true God himself will bring every sort of work into the judgment in relation to every hidden thing, as to whether it is good or bad.

- Also loving-kindness belongs to you, O Yehowah, for you yourself pay back to each one according to his work. (Psalms 62:12)
- Rejoice, young man, in your youth, and let your heart do you good in the days of your young manhood, and walk in the ways of your heart and in the things seen by your eyes. But know that on account of all these the true God will bring you into judgment. (Ecclesiastes 11:9)
- I tell you that every unprofitable saying that men speak, they will render an account concerning it on Judgment Day. (Matthew 12:36)
- But there is nothing carefully concealed that will not be revealed, and secret that will not become known. (Luke 12:2)
- Because he has set a day in which he purposes to judge the inhabited earth in righteousness by a man whom he has appointed, and he has furnished a guarantee to all men in that he has resurrected him from the dead. (Acts of Apostles 17:31)
- Hence do not judge anything before the due time, until the Lord comes, who will both bring the secret things of darkness to light and make the counsels of the hearts manifest, and then each one will have his praise come to him from God. (1 Corinthians 4:5)
- For we must all be made manifest before the judgment seat of the Christ, that each one may get his award for the things done through the body, according to the things he has practiced, whether it is good or vile. (2 Corinthians 5:10)
- The sins of some men are publicly manifest, leading directly to judgment, but as for other men their sins also become manifest later. (1 Timothy 5:24)
- And the sin that they have committed against it has become known, then the congregation must present a young bull for a sin offering and must bring it before the tent of meeting. (Leviticus 4:14)

- If it was to build for ourselves an altar so as to turn back from following Yehowah, and if it was to offer up burnt offerings and grain offerings on it, and if it was to render up communion sacrifices on it, Yehowah himself will search out. (Joshua 22:23)
- Then Benaiah the son of Jehoiada went on up and fell upon him and put him to death, and he got to be buried at his own house in the wilderness. (1 Kings 2:34)
- Will not God himself search this out? For he is aware of the secrets of the heart. (Psalms 44:21)
- These things you have done, and I kept silent. You imagined that I would positively become like you. I am going to reprove you, and I will set things in order before your eyes. (Psalms 50:21)
- I myself have said in my heart; The true God will judge both the righteous one and the wicked one, for there is a time for every affair and concerning every work there. (Ecclesiastes 3:17)
- Great in counsel and abundant in acts, you whose eyes are opened upon all the ways of the sons of men, in order to give to each one according to his ways and according to the fruitage of his dealings. (Jeremiah 32:19)
- Therefore each one according to his ways is how I shall judge YOU, O house of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. Turn back, yes, cause a turning back from all YOUR transgressions, and let nothing prove to be for YOU people a stumbling block causing error. (Ezekiel 18:30)
- And it must occur at that time that I shall carefully search Jerusalem with lamps, and I will give attention to the men who are congealing upon their dregs and who are saying in their heart; Yehowah will not do good, and he will not do bad. (Zephaniah 1:12)
- For there is nothing hidden that will not become manifest, neither anything carefully concealed that will never become known and never come into the open. (Luke 8:17)
- So, then, each of us will render an account for himself to God. (Romans 14:12)
- While God judges those outside? Remove the wicked man from among yourselves. (1 Corinthians 5:13)
