Ecclesiastes 1:7" All the winter torrents are going forth to the sea, yet the sea itself is not full. To the place where the winter torrents are going forth, there they are returning so as to go forth.

- My own brothers have dealt treacherously, like a winter torrent, like the channel of winter torrents that keep passing away. (Job 6:15)
- As for this sea so great and wide, there there are moving things without number, living creatures, small as well as great. (Psalms 104:25)
- And putting out to sea from there we sailed under the shelter of Cyprus, because the winds were contrary. (Acts of Apostles 27:4)
- And I proceeded to break up my regulation upon it and to set a bar and doors. (Job 38:10)
- For he draws up the drops of water, they filter as rain for his mist. (Job 36:27)
- For just as the pouring rain descends, and the snow, from the heavens and does not return to that place, unless it actually saturates the earth and makes it produce and sprout, and seed is actually given to the sower and bread to the eater. (Isaiah 55:10)
