- I explored with my heart by cheering my flesh even with wine, while I was leading my heart with **wisdom**, even to lay hold on folly until I could see what good there was to the sons of mankind in what they did under the heavens for the number of the days of their life. (**Ecclesiastes 2:3**)
- And Yehowah continued to make Solomon surpassingly great **before** the eyes of all Israel and to put upon him such royal dignity as had not come to be upon any king **before** him over Israel. (**1 Chronicles 29:25**)
- And Solomon the son of David continued to get strength in his kingship, and Yehowah his God was with him and kept making him surpassingly great. (**2 Chronicles 1:1**)
- The **wisdom** and the knowledge are being given you, also wealth and riches and honor I shall give you such as no kings that were prior to you **happened** to have, and such as no one after you will come to have. (**2 Chronicles 1:12**)
- I, even I, spoke with my heart, saying; Look! I myself have greatly **increased** in **wisdom** more than **anyone** that **happened** to be **before** me in **Jerusalem**, and my **own** heart saw a great deal of **wisdom** and knowledge. (**Ecclesiastes 1:16**)
