[6] - References:

- For a dream certainly comes in because of **abundance of occupation**, and the voice of a stupid one because of the **abundance of words**. (**Ecclesiastes 5:3**)
- Let all those of the earth be in **fear** of Yehowah. At him let all the inhabitants of the productive land be frightened. (**Psalms 33:8**)
- Let your heart not be envious of sinners, but be in the **fear** of Yehowah all day long. (**Proverbs 23:17**)
- It is better that you should take hold of the one, but from the other also do not withdraw your hand, for he that **fears God** will go forth with them all. (**Ecclesiastes 7:18**)
- The conclusion of the matter, everything having been heard, is; Fear the **true God** and keep his commandments. For this is the whole obligation of man. (**Ecclesiastes 12:13**)
- Who among **you** people is in **fear** of Yehowah, listening to the voice of his servant, who has walked in continual darkness and for whom there has been no brightness? Let him trust in the name of Yehowah and support himself upon his **God**. (**Isaiah 50:10**)
