

Ecclesiastes 7:16

Do not become righteous overmuch, nor show yourself excessively wise. Why should you cause desolation to yourself?

[15] - References:

- Those who are saying; Keep close to yourself. Do not approach me, for I shall certainly convey holiness to you. These are a smoke in my nostrils, a fire burning all day long. (**Isaiah 65:5**)
- Take good care not to practice **YOUR** righteousness in front of men in order to be observed by them, otherwise **YOU** will have no reward with **YOUR** Father who is in the heavens. (**Matthew 6:1**)
- At seeing this the Pharisees said to him; Look! Your disciples are doing what it is not lawful to do on the Sabbath. (**Matthew 12:2**)
- Woe to **YOU**, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! Because **YOU** give the tenth of the mint and the dill and the cumin, but **YOU** have disregarded the weightier matters of the Law, namely, justice and mercy and faithfulness. These things it was binding to do, yet not to disregard the other things. (**Matthew 23:23**)
- But he spoke this illustration also to some who trusted in themselves that they were **righteous** and who considered the rest as nothing. (**Luke 18:9**)
- For, because of not knowing the righteousness of God but seeking to establish their own, they did not subject themselves to the righteousness of God. (**Romans 10:3**)
- But why do you judge your brother? Or why do you also look down on your brother? For we shall all stand before the judgment seat of God. (**Romans 14:10**)
- Those very things are, indeed, possessed of an appearance of wisdom in a self-imposed form of worship and mock humility, a severe treatment of the body, but they are of no value in combating the satisfying of the flesh. (**Colossians 2:23**)
- Do not become wise in your own eyes. Fear Yehowah and turn away from bad. (**Proverbs 3:7**)
- Why was it this perfumed oil was not sold for three hundred denarii and given to the poor people? (**John 12:5**)

- **For through the undeserved kindness given to me I tell everyone there among **you** not to think more of himself than it is necessary to think, but to think so as to have a sound mind, each one as God has distributed to him a measure of faith. (**Romans 12:3**)**
- **Let no one be seducing himself; If anyone among **you** thinks he is wise in this system of things, let him become a fool, that he may become wise. (**1 Corinthians 3:18**)**
- **At that Yehowah's anger blazed against Uzzah and the true God struck him down there for the irreverent act, so that he died there close by the ark of the true God. (**2 Samuel 6:7**)**
- **Pride is before a crash, and a haughty spirit before stumbling. (**Proverbs 16:18**)**
- **For in the abundance of wisdom there is an abundance of vexation, so that he that increases knowledge increases pain. (**Ecclesiastes 1:18**)**
