[16] - References:

- Look! With error I was brought forth with birth pains, and in sin my mother conceived me. (**Psalms 51:5**)
- If errors were what you watch, O Yah, O Yehowah, who could stand? (**Psalms 130:3**)
- And do not enter into judgment with your servant, for before you no one alive can be **righteous**. (**Psalms 143:2**)
- Who can say; I have cleansed my heart, I have become pure from my sin? (**Proverbs 20:9**)
- For all have sinned and fall short of the glory of God. (**Romans 3:23**)
- For we all stumble many times. If anyone does not stumble in word, this one is a perfect man, able to bridle also his whole body. (**James 3:2**)
- If we make the statement; We have no sin, we are misleading ourselves and the truth is not in us. (**1 John 1:8**)
- And Yehowah began to smell a restful odor, and so Yehowah said in his heart; Never again shall I call down evil upon the ground on man's account, because the inclination of the heart of man is bad from his youth up, and never again shall I deal every living thing a blow just as I have done.
