Ecclesiastes 8:1" Who is there like the wise one? And who is there knowing the interpretation of a thing? The wisdom of a man itself causes his face to shine, and even the sternness of his face is changed for the better.

[9] - References:

- A wise person will listen and take in more instruction, and a man of understanding is the one who acquires skillful direction. (Proverbs 1:5)
- Honor is what the wise ones will come to possess, but the stupid ones are exalting dishonor. (Proverbs 3:35)
- The lips of the wise ones keep scattering knowledge about, but the heart of the stupid ones is not like that. (Proverbs 15:7)
- The ear that is listening to the reproof of life lodges right in among wise people. (Proverbs 15:31)
- At this they said to him; We have dreamed a dream, and there is no interpreter with us. So Joseph said to them; Do not interpretations belong to God? Relate it to me, please. (Genesis 40:8)
- For you know this first, that no prophecy of Scripture springs from any private interpretation. (2 Peter 1:20)
- Highly esteem it, and it will exalt you. It will glorify you because you embrace it. (Proverbs 4:8)
- Wisdom is the prime thing. Acquire wisdom, and with all that you acquire, acquire understanding. (Proverbs 4:7)
- Wisdom is before the face of the understanding one, but the eyes of the stupid one are at the extremity of the earth. (Proverbs 17:24)
