Although a sinner may be doing bad a hundred times and continuing a long time as he pleases, yet I am also aware that it will turn out well with those fearing the true God, because they were in fear of him.

[24] - References:

- Without exception no one has proved to be like Ahab, who sold himself to do what was **bad** in the eyes of Yehowah, whom Jezebel his wife egged on. (**1 Kings 21:25**)
- Sinners are the ones whom calamity pursues, but the righteous are the ones whom good rewards. (**Proverbs 13:21**)
- If, now, **God**, although having the **will** to demonstrate his wrath and to make his power known, tolerated with much long-suffering vessels of wrath made fit for destruction. (**Romans 9:22**)
- But the meek ones themselves **will** possess the earth, and they **will** indeed find their exquisite delight in the abundance of peace. (**Psalms 37:11**)
- Yehowah is **aware** of the days of the faultless ones, and their very inheritance **will** continue even to time indefinite. (**Psalms 37:18**)
- Praise Yah, **you** people! Happy is the man in **fear** of Yehowah, in whose commandments he has taken very much delight. (**Psalms 112:1**)
- He **will** bless those **fearing** Yehowah, the small ones as **well** as the great ones. (**Psalms 115:13**)
- Say, **you** men, that it **will** be **well** with the righteous one, for they **will** eat the very fruitage of their dealings. (**Isaiah 3:10**)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Look! My own servants **will** eat, but **you** yourselves **will** go hungry. Look! My own servants **will** drink, but **you** yourselves **will** go thirsty. Look! My own servants **will** rejoice, but **you** yourselves **will** suffer shame. (**Isaiah 65:13**)

- Then the king **will** say to those on his right, Come, **you** who have been blessed by my Father, inherit the kingdom prepared for **you** from the founding of the world. (**Matthew 25:34**)
- Yehowah knows how to deliver people of godly devotion **out** of trial, but to reserve unrighteous people for the day of judgment to be cut off. (**2 Peter 2:9**)
- The intimacy with Yehowah belongs to those fearful of him, also his covenant, to cause them to know it. (**Psalms 25:14**)
- Fear Yehowah, **you** holy ones of his, for there is no lack to those **fearing** him. (**Psalms 34:9**)
- As a father shows mercy to his sons, Yehowah has shown mercy to those **fearing** him. (**Psalms 103:13**)
- Let your heart not be envious of **sinners**, but be in the **fear** of Yehowah all day long. (**Proverbs 23:17**)
- And **your** father has trifled with me and he has changed my wages ten **times**, but **God** has not allowed him to do me harm. (**Genesis 31:7**)
- So **God** dealt **well** with the midwives, and the people kept growing more numerous and becoming very mighty. (**Exodus 1:20**)
- And you must listen, O Israel, and take care to do them, that it may go **well** with you and that **you** may become very many, just as Yehowah the **God** of your forefathers has promised you, as respects the land flowing with milk and honey. (**Deuteronomy 6:3**)
- Hence Yehowah commanded us to carry **out** all these regulations, to **fear** Yehowah our **God** for our good always, that we might keep alive as at this day. (**Deuteronomy 6:24**)
- Accordingly one of the priests whom they had led into exile from Samaria came and began dwelling in Bethel, and he came to be a teacher of them as to how they ought to **fear** Yehowah. (**2 Kings 17:28**)
- And I went on to say; The thing that **you** are **doing** is not good. Is it not in the **fear** of our **God** that **you** should walk because of the reproach of the nations, our enemies? (**Nehemiah 5:9**)

- **They have become high up a little while, then they are no more, and they have been brought low, like everyone else they are plucked off, and like the head of an ear of grain they are cut off. (Job 24:24)**
- **These things you have done, and I kept silent. You imagined that I would positively become like you. I **am** going to reprove you, and I **will** set things in order before your eyes. (Psalms 50:21)**
- **Look! That is how the able-bodied man **will** be blessed who **fears** Yehowah. (Psalms 128:4)**
