

Ecclesiastes 8:13

But it will not turn out well at all with the wicked one, neither will he prolong his days that are like a shadow, because he is not in fear of God.

[29] - References:

- **But if you will not do this way, you will also certainly sin against Yehowah. In that case know that your sin will catch up with you. (Numbers 32:23)**
- **The light also of wicked ones will be extinguished and the spark of his fire will not shine. (Job 18:5)**
- **Yehowah himself examines the righteous one as well as the wicked one, and anyone loving violence His soul certainly hates. (Psalms 11:5)**
- **And just a little while longer, and the wicked one will be no more, and you will certainly give attention to his place, and he will not be. (Psalms 37:10)**
- **There is no peace, my God has said, for the wicked ones. (Isaiah 57:21)**
- **And these will depart into everlasting cutting-off, but the righteous ones into everlasting life. (Matthew 25:46)**
- **But these men, like unreasoning animals born naturally to be caught and destroyed, will, in the things of which they are ignorant and speak abusively, even suffer destruction in their own course of destruction. (2 Peter 2:12)**
- **They have become high up a little while, then they are no more, and they have been brought low, like everyone else they are plucked off, and like the head of an ear of grain they are cut off. (Job 24:24)**
- **For who is there knowing what good a man has in life for the number of the days of his vain life, when he spends them like a shadow? For who can tell man what will happen after him under the sun? (Ecclesiastes 6:12)**
- **But God said to him, Unreasonable one, this night they are demanding your soul from you. Who, then, is to have the things you stored up? (Luke 12:20)**

- For the sun rises with its burning heat and withers the vegetation, and its flower drops off and the beauty of its outward appearance perishes. So, too, the rich man **will** fade away in his ways of life. (**James 1:11**)
- Also, with covetousness they **will** exploit **you** with counterfeit words. But as for them, the judgment from of old is not moving slowly, and the destruction of them is not slumbering. (**2 Peter 2:3**)
- The senseless one has said in his heart; There is no Yehowah. They have acted ruinously, they have acted detestably in their dealing. There is no one doing good. (**Psalms 14:1**)
- The utterance of transgression to the **wicked** one is in the midst of his heart, there is no dread of **God** in front of his eyes. (**Psalms 36:1**)
- If you **turn** to doing good, **will** there not be an exaltation? But if you do not **turn** to doing good, there is sin crouching at the entrance, and for you is its craving, and **will** you, for your part, get the mastery over it? (**Genesis 4:7**)
- They must also bring the girl **out** to the entrance of her father's house, and the men of her city must pelt her with stones, and she must die, because she has committed a disgraceful folly in Israel by committing prostitution in the house of her father. So you must clear away what is bad from your midst. (**Deuteronomy 22:21**)
- And there is a boundary that Yehowah has put between us and **you**, the sons of Reuben and the sons of Gad, namely, the Jordan. **You** have no share in Yehowah. And **YOUR** sons **will** certainly make our sons desist from fearing Yehowah. (**Joshua 22:25**)
- And the ark of **God** itself was captured, and the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, died. (**1 Samuel 4:11**)
- And David went on to say; As Yehowah is living, Yehowah himself **will** deal him a blow, or his day **will** come and he **will** have to die, or down into battle he **will** go, and he **will** certainly be swept away. (**1 Samuel 26:10**)
- So therefore this is what Yehowah has said; As regards the couch upon which you have gone up, you **will** not come down off

- it, because you **will** positively die. With that Elijah went off. (**2 Kings 1:4**)
- And Jehu himself filled his hand with a bow and proceeded to shoot Jehoram between the arms, so that the arrow came **out** at his heart, and he collapsed in his war chariot. (**2 Kings 9:24**)
 - Like a blossom he has come forth and is cut off, and he runs away like the **shadow** and does not keep existing. (**Job 14:2**)
 - From **out** of the city the dying keep groaning, and the soul of deadly wounded ones cries for help, and **God** himself considers it not as anything improper. (**Job 24:12**)
 - This is the share of the **wicked** man from **God**, and the inheritance of the tyrants they **will** receive from the Almighty himself. (**Job 27:13**)
 - Until I proceeded to come into the grand sanctuary of **God**. I wanted to discern their future. (**Psalms 73:17**)
 - Man himself bears resemblance to a mere exhalation, his **days** are like a passing **shadow**. (**Psalms 144:4**)
 - Though hand be to hand, a bad person **will** not go unpunished, but the offspring of the righteous ones **will** certainly escape. (**Proverbs 11:21**)
 - A man, even a stranger, is crooked in his way, but the pure one is upright in his activity. (**Proverbs 21:8**)
 - When I say to someone **wicked**, O **wicked** one, you **will** positively die! But you actually do not speak **out** to warn the **wicked** one from his way, he himself as a **wicked** one **will** die in his own error, but his blood I shall ask back at your own hand. (**Ezekiel 33:8**)
