[8] - References:

- My son, fear Yehowah and the king. With those who are for a change, do not intermeddle. (Proverbs 24:21)
- Let every soul be in subjection to the superior authorities, for there is no authority except by God, the existing authorities stand placed in their relative positions by God. (Romans 13:1)
- Continue reminding them to be in subjection and be obedient to governments and authorities as rulers, to be ready for every good work. (Titus 3:1)
- For the Lord's sake subject yourselves to every human creation; whether to a king as being superior (1 Peter 2:13)
- So all the older men of Israel came to the king at Hebron, and King David concluded a covenant with them in Hebron before Yehowah, after which they anointed David as king over Israel. (2 Samuel 5:3)
- Why, then, did you not keep the oath of Yehowah and the commandment that I solemnly laid upon you? (1 Kings 2:43)
- The hand of the true God proved to be also in Judah to give them one heart to perform the commandment of the king and the princes in the matter of Yehowah. (2 Chronicles 30:12)
