

**Ecclesiastes 8:2** I say; Keep the very order of the king, and that out of regard for the oath of God.

[8] - References:

- My son, fear Yehowah and the **king**. With those who are for a change, do not intermeddle. (**Proverbs 24:21**)
- Let every soul be in subjection to the superior authorities, for there is no authority except by **God**, the existing authorities stand placed in their relative positions by **God**. (**Romans 13:1**)
- Continue reminding them to be in subjection and be obedient to governments and authorities as rulers, to be ready for every good work. (**Titus 3:1**)
- For the Lord's sake subject yourselves to every human creation; whether to a **king** as being superior (**1 Peter 2:13**)
- So all the older men of Israel came to the **king** at Hebron, and King David concluded a covenant with them in Hebron before Yehowah, after which they anointed David as **king** over Israel. (**2 Samuel 5:3**)
- Why, then, did you not keep the **oath** of Yehowah and the commandment that I solemnly laid upon you? (**1 Kings 2:43**)
- The hand of the true **God** proved to be also in Judah to give them one heart to perform the commandment of the **king** and the princes in the matter of Yehowah. (**2 Chronicles 30:12**)
- He has thrust **out** his hands against those at peace with him, he has profaned his covenant. (**Psalms 55:20**)
