## Ecclesiastes 8:4" Because the word of the king is the power of control, and who may say to him; What are you doing?

[18] - References:

- And Pharaoh further said to Joseph; I am Pharaoh, but without your authorization no man may lift up his hand or his foot in all the land of Egypt. (Genesis 41:44)
- Immediately King Solomon sent by means of Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and he proceeded to fall upon him, so that he died. (1 Kings 2:25)
- And as for everyone that does not become a doer of the Law of your God and the Law of the king, let judgment be promptly executed upon him, whether for death or for banishment, or for money fine or for imprisonment. (Ezra 7:26)
- Now if you are ready so that when you hear the sound of the horn, the pipe, the zither, the triangular harp, the stringed instrument, and the bagpipe and all sorts of musical instruments, you fall down and worship the image that I have made, all right. But if you do not worship, at that same moment you will be thrown into the burning fiery furnace. And who is that god that can rescue you out of my hands? (Daniel 3:15)
- Let every soul be in subjection to the superior authorities, for there is no authority except by God, the existing authorities stand placed in their relative positions by God. (Romans 13:1)
- In time the king of Egypt called the midwives and said to them; Why is it you have done this thing, in that you preserved the male children alive? (Exodus 1:18)
- And he went on to say to all Israel; You yourselves will come to be on the one side, and I and Jonathan my son, we will come to be on the other side. At this the people said to Saul; What is good in your eyes do. (1 Samuel 14:40)
- For all the days that the son of Jesse is alive on the ground, you and your kingship will not be firmly established. So now send and fetch him to me, for he is destined for death. (1 Samuel 20:31)

- After that David sent messengers that he might take her. So she came in to him and he lay down with her, while she was sanctifying herself from her uncleanness. Later she returned to her house. (2 Samuel 11:4)
- So he wrote in the letter, saying; Put Uriah in front of the heaviest battle charges, and you men must retreat from behind him, and he must be struck down and die. (2 Samuel 11:15)
- But she said; Let the king, please, remember Yehowah your God, that the avenger of blood may not be continually causing ruin and that they may not annihilate my son. To this he said; As Yehowah is living, not a single hair of your son will fall to the earth. (2 Samuel 14:11)
- Finally the king's word prevailed upon Joab and the chiefs of the military forces. So Joab and the chiefs of the military forces went out from before the king to register the people Israel. (2 Samuel 24:4)
- The king's word, however, prevailed over Joab, so that Joab went out and walked through all Israel, after which he came to Jerusalem. (1 Chronicles 21:4)
- However, Asa became offended at the seer and put him in the house of the stocks, because he was in a rage at him over this. And Asa began to crush some others of the people at that same time. (2 Chronicles 16:10)
- And by me myself, Artaxerxes the king, an order has been put through to all the treasurers that are beyond the River, that everything that Ezra the priest, the copyist of the Law of the God of the heavens, requests of YOU men it will be done promptly. (Ezra 7:21)
- And he proceeded to write in the name of King Ahasuerus and do the sealing with the king's signet ring and send written documents by the hand of the couriers on horses, riding post horses used in the royal service, sons of speedy mares. (Esther 8:10)
- Shall one say to a king; You are good for nothing? To nobles; You are wicked? (Job 34:18)

Therefore he who opposes the authority has taken a stand against the arrangement of God, those who have taken a stand against it will receive judgment to themselves. (Romans 13:2)
