

**Ecclesiastes 9:10**

**All that your hand finds to do, do with your very power, for there is no work nor devising nor knowledge nor wisdom in Sheol,<sup>1</sup> the place to which you are going.**

- **And in every work that he started in the service of the house of the true God and in the Law and in the commandment to search for his God, it was with all his heart that he acted, and he proved successful. (2 Chronicles 31:21)**
- **For it is not Sheol that can laud you, death itself cannot praise you. Those going down into the pit cannot look hopefully to your trueness. (Isaiah 38:18)**
- **His spirit goes out, he goes back to his ground, in that day his thoughts do perish. (Psalms 146:4)**
- **And all his sons and all his daughters kept rising up to comfort him, but he kept refusing to take comfort and saying; For I shall go down mourning to my son into Sheol! And his father continued weeping for him. (Genesis 37:35)**
- **And you must act according to your wisdom, and not let his gray hairs go down in peace to Sheol. (1 Kings 2:6)**
- **Therefore Sheol has made its soul spacious and has opened its mouth wide beyond bounds, and what is splendid in her, also her crowd and her uproar and the exultant one, will certainly go down into it. (Isaiah 5:14)**
- **The dead themselves do not praise Yah, nor do any going down into silence. (Psalms 115:17)**
- **However, he said; My son will not go down with you men, because his brother is dead and he has been left by himself. If a fatal accident should befall him on the way on which you would go, then you would certainly bring down my gray hairs with grief to Sheol. (Genesis 42:38)**
- **If you were to take this one also out of my sight and a fatal accident were to befall him, you would certainly bring down my gray hairs with calamity to Sheol. (Genesis 44:29)**

- **Now, look! I am going today in the way of all the earth, and YOU well know with all YOUR hearts and with all YOUR souls that not one word out of all the good words that Yehowah YOUR God has spoken to YOU has failed. They have all come true for YOU. Not one word of them has failed. (Joshua 23:14)**
- **And Samuel began to say to Saul; Why have you disturbed me by having me brought up? To this Saul said; I am in very sore straits, as the Philistines are fighting against me, and God himself has departed from me and has answered me no more, either by means of the prophets or by dreams, so that I am calling you to let me know what I shall do. (1 Samuel 28:15)**
- **Now that he has died, why is it I am fasting? Am I able to bring him back again? I am going to him, but, as for him, he will not return to me. (2 Samuel 12:23)**
- **I am going in the way of all the earth, and you must be strong and prove yourself to be a man. (1 Kings 2:2)**
- **Accordingly David said; Solomon my son is young and delicate, and the house to be built to Yehowah is to be surpassingly magnificent for beauteous distinction to all the lands. Let me, then, make preparation for him. So David made preparation in great quantities before his death. (1 Chronicles 22:5)**
- **And according to all my power I have prepared for the house of my God the gold for the goldwork, and the silver for the silverwork, and the copper for the copperwork, the iron for the ironwork, and the timbers for the timberwork, onyx stones, and stones to be set with hard mortar, and mosaic pebbles, and every precious stone, and alabaster stones in great quantity. (1 Chronicles 29:2)**
- **Accordingly his servants took him down from the chariot and had him ride in the second war chariot that was his and brought him to Jerusalem. Thus he died and was buried in the graveyard of his forefathers, and all Judah and Jerusalem were mourning over Josiah. (2 Chronicles 35:24)**
- **After him Baruch the son of Zabbai worked with fervor and repaired another measured section, from the Buttress as far as the entrance of the house of Eliashib the High Priest. (Nehemiah 3:20)**

- **So I sent messengers to them, saying; It is a great **work** that I am doing, and I am not able to go down. Why should the **work** cease while I take off from it and have to go down to **you**? (**Nehemiah 6:3**)**
- **For by now I should have lain down that I might be undisturbed, I should have slept then, I should be at rest (**Job 3:13**)**
- **There the wicked themselves have ceased from agitation, and there those weary in **power** are at rest. (**Job 3:17**)**
- **The cloud certainly comes to its end and goes away, so he that is **going** down to Sheol will not come up. (**Job 7:9**)**
- **Before I go away, and I shall not come back, to the land of darkness and deep shadow. (**Job 10:21**)**
- **But an able-bodied man dies and lies vanquished, and an earthling man expires, and where is he? (**Job 14:10**)**
- **For in death there is no mention of you, in Sheol who will laud you? (**Psalms 6:5**)**
- **What profit is there in my blood when I go down to the pit? Will the dust laud you? Will it tell of your trueness? (**Psalms 30:9**)**
- **All are **going** to one **place**. They have all come to be from the dust, and they are all returning to the dust. (**Ecclesiastes 3:20**)**
- **Who is there knowing the spirit of the sons of mankind, whether it is ascending upward, and the spirit of the beast, whether it is descending downward to the earth? (**Ecclesiastes 3:21**)**
- **Also, their love and their hate and their jealousy have already perished, and they have no portion anymore to time indefinite in anything that has to be done under the sun. (**Ecclesiastes 9:6**)**
- **If an iron tool has become blunt and someone has not whetted its edge, then he will exert his own vital energies. So the using of **wisdom** to success means advantage. (**Ecclesiastes 10:10**)**
- **In the morning sow your seed and until the evening do not let your **hand** rest, for you are not knowing where this will have success, either here or there, or whether both of them will alike be good. (**Ecclesiastes 11:6**)**

- **Also, they have become afraid merely at what is high, and there are terrors in the way. And the almond tree carries blossoms, and the grasshopper drags itself along, and the caper berry bursts, because man is walking to his long-lasting house and the wailers have marched around in the street. (Ecclesiastes 12:5)**
- **Even Sheol underneath has become agitated at you in order to meet you on coming in. At you it has awakened those impotent in death, all the goatlike leaders of the earth. It has made all the kings of the nations get up from their thrones. (Isaiah 14:9)**
- **We must **work** the **works** of him that sent me while it is day, the night is coming when no man can **work**. (John 9:4)**
