For man also does not know his time. Just like fishes that are being taken in an evil net, and like birds that are being taken in a trap, so the sons of men themselves are being ensnared at a calamitous time, when it falls upon them suddenly.

- All these he has brought up with a mere fishhook, he drags them away in his dragnet, and he gathers them in his fishing net. That is why he rejoices and is joyful. (Habakkuk 1:15)
- Until an arrow cleaves open his liver, just as a bird hastens into the trap, and he has not known that it involves his very soul. (Proverbs 7:23)
- But pay attention to yourselves that YOUR hearts never become weighed down with overeating and heavy drinking and anxieties of life, and suddenly that day be instantly upon YOU. (Luke 21:34)
- As a snare. For it will come in upon all those dwelling upon the face of all the earth. (Luke 21:35)
- And he went on to say; Here, now, I have become old. I do not know the day of my death. (Genesis 27:2)
- Accordingly he carried him and brought him to his mother. And he kept sitting upon her knees until noon, and gradually he died. (2 Kings 4:20)

- So now call all the prophets of Baal, all his worshipers and all his priests to me. Do not let a single one be missing, because I have a great sacrifice for Baal. Anyone that is missing will not keep living. As for Jehu, he acted slyly, for the purpose of destroying the worshipers of Baal. (2 Kings 10:19)
- The very ropes of Sheol surrounded me, the snares of death confronted me. (Psalms 18:5)
- They will not be ashamed in the time of calamity, and in the days of famine they will be satisfied. (Psalms 37:19)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, I will also spread over you my net by means of a congregation of many peoples, and they will certainly bring you in my dragnet. (Ezekiel 32:3)
- Whichever way they go, I shall spread out over them my net. Like flying creatures of the heavens I shall bring them down. I shall discipline them in agreement with the report to their assembly. (Hosea 7:12)
- Will a bird fall into a trap on the earth when there is no snare for it? Does a trap go up from the ground when it has absolutely caught nothing? (Amos 3:5)
