- Into your hand I entrust my spirit. You have redeemed me, O Yehowah the **God of truth**. (**Psalms 31:5**)
- After that Joshua said; By this **you will** know that a **living God** is in **YOUR** midst, and that he **will** without fail drive away from before **you** the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Hivites and the Perizzites and the Girgashites and the Amorites and the Jebusites. (**Joshua 3:10**)
- From before me there has been put through an order that, in every dominion of my kingdom, people are to be quaking and fearing before the **God** of Daniel. For he is the **living God** and One enduring to times **indefinite**, and his kingdom is one that **will** not be brought to ruin, and his dominion is forever. (**Daniel 6:26**)
- Just as the **living** Father sent me forth and I live because of the Father, he also that feeds on me, even that one **will** live because of me. (**John 6:57**)
- And what agreement does God's temple have with idols? For we are a temple of a **living God**, just as **God** said; I shall reside among them and walk among them, and I shall be their **God**, and they **will** be my people. (**2 Corinthians 6:16**)
- For they themselves keep reporting about the way we first entered in among **you** and how **you** turned to **God** from **YOUR** idols to slave for a **living** and true **God**. (**1 Thessalonians 1:9**)
- Yehowah is **King** to time **indefinite**, even forever. The **nations** have perished out of his **earth**. (**Psalms 10:16**)
- Are you not from long ago, O Yehowah? O my **God**, my Holy One, you do not die. O Yehowah, for a judgment you have set it, and, O Rock, for a reproving you have founded it. (**Habakkuk 1:12**)

- How grand his signs are, and how mighty his wonders are! His kingdom is a kingdom to time **indefinite**, and his rulership is for generation after generation. (**Daniel 4:3**)
- And they are singing the song of Moses the slave of **God** and the song of the Lamb, saying; Great and wonderful are your works, Yehowah **God**, the Almighty. Righteous and true are your ways, **King** of eternity. (**Revelation 15:3**)
- Mountains themselves have rocked because of him, and the very hills found themselves melting. And the **earth will** be upheaved because of his face, the productive land also, and all those dwelling in it. (**Nahum 1:5**)
- You, fear-inspiring you are, and who can stand before you because of the strength of your anger? (**Psalms 76:7**)
- Who is there knowing the strength of your anger and your fury according to the fear of you? (**Psalms 90:11**)
- And Yehowah himself **will** certainly give forth his voice before his military force, for his camp is very numerous. For he who is carrying out his word is mighty, for the day of Yehowah is great and very fear-inspiring, and who can **hold up under** it? (**Joel 2:11**)
- After that he planted a tamarisk tree at Beersheba and called there upon the name of Yehowah the indefinitely lasting **God**. (**Genesis 21:33**)
- Divine One, **God**, Yehowah, Divine One, **God**, Yehowah, he is knowing, and Israel, he too **will** know. If it is in rebellion and if it is in unfaithfulness against Yehowah, do not save us this day. (**Joshua 22:22**)
- And David began to say to the men that were standing close by him; What **will** be done to the man that strikes down that Philistine over there and actually turns away reproach from upon Israel? For who is this uncircumcised Philistine that he has to taunt the battle lines of the **living** God? (**1 Samuel 17:26**)
- Both the lion and the bear your servant struck down, and this uncircumcised Philistine must become like one of them, for he has taunted the battle lines of the **living** God. (**1 Samuel 17:36**)

- Then Saul obeyed the voice of Jonathan, and Saul swore; As Yehowah is **living**, he **will** not be put to death. (**1 Samuel 19:6**)
- But David swore in addition and said; Your father must surely know that I have found favor in your eyes, and so would say; Do not let Jonathan know this for fear he may feel hurt. But, in fact, as Yehowah is **living** and as your soul is **living**, there is just about a step between me and death! (**1 Samuel 20:3**)
- To the end that all the peoples of the **earth** may know that Yehowah is the true **God**. There is no other. (**1 Kings 8:60**)
- Whoever there is among **you** of all his people, may his **God** prove to be with him. So let him go up to Jerusalem, which is in Judah, and rebuild the house of Yehowah the **God** of Israel, he is the true God, which was in Jerusalem. (**Ezra 1:3**)
- He is moving mountains away, so that people do not even know of them, he who has overthrown them in his anger. (**Job 9:5**)
- Are your days like the days of mortal man, or your years just like the days of an able-bodied man. (**Job 10:5**)
- Yehowah is **living**, and blessed be my Rock, and let the **God** of my salvation be exalted. (**Psalms 18:46**)
- My soul indeed thirsts for **God**, for the **living God**. When shall I come and appear before **God**? (**Psalms 42:2**)
- **God will** hear and answer them, even He that is sitting enthroned as in the past. Those with whom there are no changings and who have not feared **God**. (**Psalms 55:19**)
- Say to **God**; How fear-inspiring your works are! Because of the abundance of your strength your enemies **will** come cringing to you. (**Psalms 66:3**)
- Before the mountains themselves were born, or you proceeded to bring forth as with labor pains the **earth** and the productive land, even from time **indefinite** to time **indefinite** you are **God**. (**Psalms 90:2**)
- For Yehowah is a great **God** and a great **King** over all other gods. (**Psalms 95:3**)

- Know that Yehowah is **God**. It is he that has made us, and not we ourselves. We are his people and the sheep of his pasturage. (**Psalms 100:3**)
- For, look! The true Lord, Yehowah of armies, is removing from Jerusalem and from Judah support and stay, the whole support of bread and the whole support of water. (**Isaiah 3:1**)
- And you must give them a command for their masters, saying; This is what Yehowah of armies, the **God** of Israel, has said, this is what **YOU** should say to **YOUR** masters. (**Jeremiah 27:4**)
- At the sound of the outcry of your sailors the open country **will rock**. (**Ezekiel 27:28**)
- And at the end of the days I, Nebuchadnezzar, lifted up to the heavens my eyes, and my own understanding began to return to me, and I blessed the Most High himself, and the One **living** to time **indefinite** I praised and glorified, because his rulership is a rulership to time **indefinite** and his kingdom is for generation after generation. (**Daniel 4:34**)
- And I shall certainly make her that was limping a remnant, and her that was removed far off a mighty nation, and Yehowah **will** actually rule as king over them in Mount Zion, from now on and into time **indefinite**. (**Micah 4:7**)
- In the face of his **denunciation** who can stand? And who can rise up against the heat of his anger? His own rage **will** certainly be poured out like fire, and the very **rocks will** actually be pulled down because of him. (**Nahum 1:6**)
- Therefore keep yourselves in expectation of me, is the utterance of Yehowah, till the day of my rising up to the booty, for my judicial decision is to gather **nations**, for me to collect together kingdoms, in order to pour out upon them my **denunciation**, all my burning anger, for by the fire of my zeal all the **earth will** be devoured. (**Zephaniah 3:8**)
- And cursed is the one acting cunningly when there exists in his drove a male animal, and he is making a vow and sacrificing a ruined one to Yehowah. For I am a great King, Yehowah of armies has said, and my name **will** be fear-inspiring among the nations. (**Malachi 1:14**)

- **For his invisible qualities are clearly seen from the world's creation onward, because they are perceived by the things made, even his eternal power and Godship, so that they are inexcusable. (Romans 1:20)**
- **And by the One who lives forever and ever, who created the heaven and the things in it and the earth and the things in it and the sea and the things in it, he swore; There will be no delay any longer. (Revelation 10:6)**
