- And the valueless **gods** themselves **will** pass away completely. (**Isaiah 2:18**)
- They are vanity, a work of mockery. In the time of their being given attention they **will perish**. (**Jeremiah 51:18**)
- Yehowah **will** be fear-inspiring against them, for he **will** certainly emaciate all the **gods** of the **earth**, and people **will** bow down to him, each one from his place, all the islands of the nations. (**Zephaniah 2:11**)
- They are vanity, a work of mockery. In the time of their being given attention they **will perish**. (**Jeremiah 51:18**)
- And it must occur in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, that I shall cut off the names of the idols out of the land, and they **will** no more be remembered, and also the prophets and the spirit of uncleanness I shall cause to pass out of the land. (**Zechariah 13:2**)
- When they got up early in the morning the very day after, there Dagon was fallen upon his face to the **earth** before the ark of Yehowah, with the head of Dagon and the palms of both his hands cut off, to the threshold. Only the fish part had been left upon him. (**1 Samuel 5:4**)
