Jeremiah 10:12... He¹ is the Maker of the earth by his power, the One firmly establishing the productive land² by his wisdom, and the One who by his understanding stretched out the heavens.

- Where did you happen to be when I founded the earth? Tell me, if you do know understanding. (Job 38:4)
- Heaven is yours, the earth also is yours, the productive land and what fills it, you yourself have founded them. (Psalms 89:11)
- Have you not come to know or have you not heard? Yehowah, the Creator of the extremities of the earth, is a God to time indefinite. He does not tire out or grow weary. There is no searching out of his understanding. (Isaiah 40:28)
- He is the Maker of the earth by his power, the One firmly establishing the productive land by his wisdom, and the One who by his understanding stretched out the heavens. (Jeremiah 51:15)
- And saying; Men, why are you doing these things? We also are humans having the same infirmities as you do, and are declaring the Good News to you, for you to turn from these vain things to the living God, who made the heaven and the earth and the sea and all the things in them. (Acts of Apostles 14:15)
- You are worthy, Yehowah, even our God, to receive the glory and the honor and the power, because you created all things, and because of your will they existed and were created. (Revelation 4:11)
- For upon the seas he himself has solidly fixed it, and upon the rivers he keeps it firmly established. (Psalms 24:2)
- Yehowah himself has become king! With eminence he is clothed, Yehowah is clothed, with strength he has girded himself. The

- productive land also becomes firmly established so that it cannot be made to totter. (Psalms 93:1)
- Yehowah himself in wisdom founded the earth. He solidly fixed the heavens in discernment. (Proverbs 3:19)
- For this is what Yehowah has said, the Creator of the heavens, He the true God, the Former of the earth and the Maker of it, He the One who firmly established it, who did not create it simply for nothing, who formed it even to be inhabited; I am Yehowah, and there is no one else. (Isaiah 45:18)
- Stretching out the heavens by himself and treading upon the high waves of the sea. (Job 9:8)
- Enwrapping yourself with light as with a garment, stretching out the heavens like a tent cloth. (Psalms 104:2)
- To the One making the heavens with understanding, for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (Psalms 136:5)
- There is One who is dwelling above the circle of the earth, the dwellers in which are as grasshoppers, the One who is stretching out the heavens just as a fine gauze, who spreads them out like a tent in which to dwell. (Isaiah 40:22)
- This is what the true God, Yehowah, has said, the Creator of the heavens and the Grand One stretching them out, the One laying out the earth and its produce, the One giving breath to the people on it, and spirit to those walking in it. (Isaiah 42:5)
- I myself have made the earth and have created even man upon it. I, my own hands have stretched out the heavens, and all the army of them I have commanded. (Isaiah 45:12)
- A pronouncement! The word of Yehowah concerning Israel, is the utterance of Yehowah, the One who is stretching out the heavens and laying the foundation of the earth and forming the spirit of man inside him. (Zechariah 12:1)
- Yours, O Yehowah, are the greatness and the mightiness and the beauty and the excellency and the dignity, for everything in the heavens and in the earth is yours. Yours is the kingdom, O Yehowah, the One also lifting yourself up as head over all. (1 Chronicles 29:11)

- With him there are wisdom and mightiness, he has counsel and understanding. (Job 12:13)
- Who put wisdom in the cloud layers, or who gave understanding to the sky phenomenon? (Job 38:36)
- Before the mountains themselves were born, or you proceeded to bring forth as with labor pains the earth and the productive land, even from time indefinite to time indefinite you are God. (Psalms 90:2)
- How many your works are, O Yehowah! All of them in wisdom you have made. The earth is full of your productions. (Psalms 104:24)
- The Maker of heaven and earth, of the sea, and of all that is in them, the One keeping trueness to time indefinite. (Psalms 146:6)
- When he prepared the heavens I was there, when he decreed a circle upon the face of the watery deep. (Proverbs 8:27)
- O Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, sitting upon the cherubs, you alone are the true God of all the kingdoms of the earth. You yourself have made the heavens and the earth. (Isaiah 37:16)
