- Crash upon crash is what **has** been called **out**, for the whole land **has** been **despoiled**. Suddenly my **tents have** been **despoiled**, in a moment my **tent cloths**. (**Jeremiah 4:20**)
- He **has** trodden his bow like an enemy. His right hand **has** taken its position like an adversary, and he kept killing all those desirable to the eyes. Into the **tent** of the daughter of Zion he **has** poured **out** his rage, just like fire. (**Lamentations 2:4**)
- This is what Yehowah **has** said, In Ramah a voice is being heard, lamentation and bitter weeping, Rachel weeping over her **sons**. She **has** refused to be comforted over her **sons**, because they are no more. (**Jeremiah 31:15**)
- Behold Zion, the town of our festal occasions! Your **own** eyes will see Jerusalem an undisturbed abiding place, a **tent** that no one will pack up. Never will its **tent** pins be pulled **out**, and none of its ropes will be **torn** in **two**. (**Isaiah 33:20**)
