- For, here I am calling for all the families of the kingdoms of the north, is the utterance of Yehowah, and they will certainly **come** and place each one his throne at the entrance of the gates of Jerusalem, and against all her walls round about and against all the **cities** of **Judah**. (**Jeremiah 1:15**)
- Raise a signal toward Zion. Make provision for shelter. Do not stand still. For there is a calamity that I am bringing in from the **north**, even a **great** crash. (**Jeremiah 4:6**)
- This is what Yehowah **has** said; Look! A people is coming from the **land** of the **north**, and there is a **great** nation that will be awakened from the remotest parts of the earth. (**Jeremiah 6:22**)
- For here I am raising up the Chaldeans, the nation bitter and impetuous, which is going to the wide-open places of earth in **order** to take possession of residences not belonging to it. (**Habakkuk 1:6**)
- And I will **make** Jerusalem piles of stones, the **lair** of **jackals**, and the **cities** of **Judah** I shall **make** a **desolate waste**, without an inhabitant. (**Jeremiah 9:11**)
- At this Yehowah said to me; Out of the **north** the calamity will be loosened against all the inhabitants of the **land**. (**Jeremiah 1:14**)
- For this is what Yehowah **has** said; A **desolate waste** is what the whole **land** will become, and shall I not carry out a sheer extermination? (**Jeremiah 4:27**)
- Take shelter, O **you** sons of Benjamin, from the midst of Jerusalem, and in Tekoa blow the horn. And over Beth-haccherem raise a fire signal, because calamity itself **has** looked down out of the **north**, even a **great** crash. (**Jeremiah 6:1**)
- The bow and the javelin they will grab hold of. It is a cruel one, and they will have no pity. Their very voice will resound just like

the sea, and upon horses they will ride. It is drawn up in battle **order** like a man of war against you, O daughter of Zion. **(Jeremiah 6:23)**

- One **has** made it a **desolate waste**, it **has** withered away, it is desolated to me. The whole **land has** been made **desolate**, because there is no man that **has** taken it to heart. **(Jeremiah 12:11)**
- And Hazor must become the **lair** of **jackals**, a **desolate waste** to time indefinite. No man will dwell there, and in her no son of mankind will reside as an alien. **(Jeremiah 49:33)**
