

Jeremiah 10:24· **Correct me, O Yehowah, however with judgment, not in your anger, that you may not reduce me to nothing.**

[8] - References:

- **O Yehowah**, do not in your **anger** reprove me, and do not in your rage correct me. (**Psalms 6:1**)
- For I am with you, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, to save you, but I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I have scattered you. However, in your case I shall make no extermination. And I shall have to correct you to the proper degree, as I shall by no means leave you unpunished. (**Jeremiah 30:11**)
- **O Yehowah**, do not in your indignation reprove me, nor in your rage correct me. (**Psalms 38:1**)
- The One who is reducing high officials to **nothing**, who has made the very judges of the earth as a mere unreality. (**Isaiah 40:23**)
- And one corrects him according to what is right. His own God instructs him. (**Isaiah 28:26**)
- And therefore **Yehowah** will keep in expectation of showing **you** favor, and therefore he will rise up to show **you** mercy. For **Yehowah** is a God of **judgment**. Happy are all those keeping in expectation of him. (**Isaiah 30:18**)
- As for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, for I am with you. For I shall make an extermination among all the nations to which I have dispersed you, but with you I shall make no extermination. Yet I shall have to chastise you to the proper degree, and I shall absolutely not leave you unpunished. (**Jeremiah 46:28**)
- Are you not from long ago, O **Yehowah**? O my God, my Holy One, you do not die. O **Yehowah**, for a **judgment** you have set it, and, O Rock, for a reproving you have founded it. (**Habakkuk 1:12**)
