- This is what **Yehowah has said**; **Here I am bringing calamity** upon this place and upon its inhabitants, even all the words of the book that the king of Judah **has** read. (**2 Kings 22:16**)
- This is what **Yehowah has said**, **Here I am bringing calamity** upon this place and its inhabitants, all the curses that are written in the book that they read before the king of Judah. (**2 Chronicles 34:24**)
- Listen, O earth! Here I **am bringing in calamity** upon this people as the fruitage of their thoughts, for they paid no attention to my very own words, and my law, they also kept rejecting it. (**Jeremiah 6:19**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah has said**; A **calamity**, a unique **calamity**, look! It is coming. (**Ezekiel 7:5**)
- A man repeatedly reprov'd but making his neck hard **will** suddenly be broken, and that without healing. (**Proverbs 29:1**)
- And a place to which to flee must perish from the swift one, and no one strong **will** reinforce his power, and no mighty man **will** provide his soul with escape. (**Amos 2:14**)
- They cry for help, but there is no savior, to **Yehowah**, but he actually does not answer them. (**Psalms 18:41**)
- At that time they **will** keep calling me, but I shall not answer, they **will** keep looking for me, but they **will** not find me. (**Proverbs 1:28**)
- And when **YOU** spread **out YOUR** palms, I hide my eyes from **YOU**. Even though **YOU** make many prayers, I **am** not listening, with bloodshed **YOUR** very hands have become filled. (**Isaiah 1:15**)
- When they fast, I **am** not listening to their entreating cry, and when they offer up the whole burnt offering and the grain offering, I **am** taking no pleasure in them, for by the sword and

by famine and by pestilence I **am bringing** them to their end.
(**Jeremiah 14:12**)

- And I myself also shall act in rage. My eye **will** not feel sorry, neither shall I feel compassion. And they **will certainly call out** in my ears with a loud voice, but I shall not hear them. (**Ezekiel 8:18**)
- At that time they **will call** to **Yehowah** for **aid**, but he **will** not answer them. And he **will** conceal his face from them in that time, according as they committed badness in their dealings. (**Micah 3:4**)
- And so it occurred that, just as he called and they did not **listen**, so they would **call** and I would not listen, **Yehowah** of armies **has said**. (**Zechariah 7:13**)
- Will God hear an outcry of his in case distress comes upon him? (**Job 27:9**)
- Only the untruth God does not hear, and the Almighty himself does not behold it. (**Job 35:13**)
- Son of man, as regards these men, they have brought up their dungy idols upon their heart, and the stumbling block causing their error they have put in front of their faces. Shall I be inquired of at all by them? (**Ezekiel 14:3**)
- With their flock and with their herd they proceeded to go and look for **Yehowah**, but they could not find him. He had drawn away from them. (**Hosea 5:6**)
