Jeremiah 11:11... Therefore this is what Yehowah has said, Here I am bringing upon them a calamity that they will not be able to get out of, and they will certainly call to me for aid, but I shall not listen to them.

- This is what Yehowah has said; Here I am bringing calamity upon this place and upon its inhabitants, even all the words of the book that the king of Judah has read. (2 Kings 22:16)
- This is what Yehowah has said, Here I am bringing calamity upon this place and its inhabitants, all the curses that are written in the book that they read before the king of Judah. (2 Chronicles 34:24)
- Listen, O earth! Here I am bringing in calamity upon this people as the fruitage of their thoughts, for they paid no attention to my very own words, and my law, they also kept rejecting it. (Jeremiah 6:19)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; A calamity, a unique calamity, look! It is coming. (Ezekiel 7:5)
- A man repeatedly reproved but making his neck hard will suddenly be broken, and that without healing. (Proverbs 29:1)
- And a place to which to flee must perish from the swift one, and no one strong will reinforce his power, and no mighty man will provide his soul with escape. (Amos 2:14)
- They cry for help, but there is no savior, to Yehowah, but he actually does not answer them. (Psalms 18:41)
- At that time they will keep calling me, but I shall not answer, they will keep looking for me, but they will not find me. (Proverbs 1:28)
- And when you spread out your palms, I hide my eyes from you. Even though you make many prayers, I am not listening, with bloodshed your very hands have become filled. (Isaiah 1:15)
- When they fast, I am not listening to their entreating cry, and when they offer up the whole burnt offering and the grain offering, I am taking no pleasure in them, for by the sword and

- by famine and by pestilence I am bringing them to their end. (Jeremiah 14:12)
- And I myself also shall act in rage. My eye will not feel sorry, neither shall I feel compassion. And they will certainly call out in my ears with a loud voice, but I shall not hear them. (Ezekiel 8:18)
- At that time they will call to Yehowah for aid, but he will not answer them. And he will conceal his face from them in that time, according as they committed badness in their dealings. (Micah 3:4)
- And so it occurred that, just as he called and they did not listen, so they would call and I would not listen, Yehowah of armies has said. (Zechariah 7:13)
- Will God hear an outcry of his in case distress comes upon him?(Job 27:9)
- Only the untruth God does not hear, and the Almighty himself does not behold it. (Job 35:13)
- Son of man, as regards these men, they have brought up their dungy idols upon their heart, and the stumbling block causing their error they have put in front of their faces. Shall I be inquired of at all by them? (Ezekiel 14:3)
- With their flock and with their herd they proceeded to go and look for Yehowah, but they could not find him. He had drawn away from them. (Hosea 5:6)
