Jeremiah 11:13... For your gods have become as many as your cities, O

Judah, and as many altars as the streets of Jerusalem you people
have placed for the shameful thing, altars to make sacrificial
smoke to Baal.

[6] - References:

- They went sacrificing to demons, not to God, Gods whom they had not known, new ones who recently came in, with whom YOUR forefathers were not acquainted. (Deuteronomy 32:17)
- Like grapes in the wilderness I found Israel. Like the early fig on a fig tree in its beginning I saw the forefathers of YOU people. They themselves went in to Baal of Peor, and they proceeded to dedicate themselves to the shameful thing, and they came to be disgusting like the thing of their love. (Hosea 9:10)
- Can there be stealing, murdering and committing adultery and swearing falsely and making sacrificial smoke to Baal and walking after other gods whom you had not known. (Jeremiah 7:9)
- But where are your gods that you have made for yourself? Let them rise up if they can save you in the time of your calamity. For as the number of your cities your gods have become, O Judah. (Jeremiah 2:28)
- But the shameful thing itself has eaten up the toil of our forefathers from our youth, their flocks and their herds, their sons and their daughters. (Jeremiah 3:24)
- As for the sacrificial smoke that you made in the cities of Judah and in the streets of Jerusalem, you and your forefathers, your kings and your princes and the people of the land, was it not this that Yehowah remembered and that proceeded to come up into his heart? (Jeremiah 44:21)
