

Jeremiah 11:13 **For your gods have become as many as your cities, O Judah, and as many altars as the streets of Jerusalem you people have placed for the shameful thing, altars to make sacrificial smoke to Baal.**

[6] - References:

- They went sacrificing to demons, not to God, Gods whom they had not known, new ones who recently came in, with whom **YOUR** forefathers were not acquainted. (**Deuteronomy 32:17**)
- Like grapes in the wilderness I found Israel. Like the early fig on a fig tree in its beginning I saw the forefathers of **you people**. They themselves went in to Baal of Peor, and they proceeded to dedicate themselves to the **shameful** thing, and they came to be disgusting like the thing of their love. (**Hosea 9:10**)
- Can there be stealing, murdering and committing adultery and swearing falsely and making **sacrificial smoke** to Baal and walking after other gods whom **you** had not known. (**Jeremiah 7:9**)
- But where are your gods that you **have** made for yourself? Let them rise up if they can save you in the time of your calamity. For as the number of your **cities** your gods **have become**, O **Judah**. (**Jeremiah 2:28**)
- But the **shameful** thing itself has eaten up the toil of our forefathers from our youth, their flocks and their herds, their sons and their daughters. (**Jeremiah 3:24**)
- As for the **sacrificial smoke** that **you** made in the **cities** of **Judah** and in the **streets** of **Jerusalem**, **you** and **YOUR** forefathers, **YOUR** kings and **YOUR** princes and the **people** of the land, was it not this that Yehowah remembered and that proceeded to come up into his heart? (**Jeremiah 44:21**)
