Jeremiah 11:16... A luxuriant olive tree, pretty with fruit and in form, is what Yehowah has called your name. With sound of the great roaring, he has set a fire blazing against her, and they have broken its branches.

- But I shall be like a luxuriant olive tree in God's house; I do trust in the loving-kindness of God to time indefinite, even forever. (Psalms 52:8)
- However, if some of the branches were broken off but you, although being a wild olive, were grafted in among them and became a sharer of the olive's root of fatness. (Romans 11:17)
- Already the ax is lying at the root of the trees, every tree, then, that does not produce fine fruit is to be cut down and thrown into the fire. (Matthew 3:10)
