Jeremiah 11:4" Which I commanded Your forefathers in the day of my bringing them out of the land of Egypt, out of the furnace of iron, saying; Obey my voice, and You must do things according to all that I command You, and You will certainly become my people and I myself shall become Your God.<sup>1</sup>

- Then Moses came and related to the people all the words of Yehowah and all the judicial decisions, and all the people answered with one voice and said; All the words that Yehowah has spoken we are willing to do. (Exodus 24:3)
- In that day I lifted up my hand in an oath to them to bring them forth from the land of Egypt to a land that I had spied out for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the lands. (Ezekiel 20:6)
- And Moses went on to say to the people; Let there be a remembering of this day on which you went out of Egypt, from the house of slaves, because by strength of hand Yehowah brought you out from here. So nothing leavened may be eaten. (Exodus 13:3)
- But you are the ones Yehowah took that he might bring you out of the iron furnace, out of Egypt, to become a people of private ownership to him as at this day. (Deuteronomy 4:20)
- For they are your people and your inheritance, whom you brought out from Egypt, from inside the iron furnace. (1 Kings 8:51)
- If you continue walking in my statutes and keeping my commandments and you do carry them out. (Leviticus 26:3)
- In turn Samuel said; Does Yehowah have as much delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices as in obeying the voice of Yehowah? Look! To obey is better than a sacrifice, to pay attention than the fat of rams. (1 Samuel 15:22)
- But this word I did express in command upon them, saying;
  Obey my voice, and I will become YOUR God, and YOU yourselves will become my people, and YOU must walk in all the way that I

- shall command you, in order that it may go well with you. (Jeremiah 7:23)
- And I will give to you and to your seed after you the land of your alien residences, even the entire land of Canaan, for a possession to time indefinite, and I will prove myself God to them. (Genesis 17:8)
- And I shall indeed walk in the midst of you and prove myself your God, and you, on your part, will prove yourselves my people. (Leviticus 26:12)
- In order that they may walk in my own statutes and keep my own judicial decisions and actually carry them out, and they may really become my people and I myself may become their God. (Ezekiel 11:20)
- And what agreement does God's temple have with idols? For we are a temple of a living God, just as God said; I shall reside among them and walk among them, and I shall be their God, and they will be my people. (2 Corinthians 6:16)
- I am Yehowah Your God, who brought You out of the land of Egypt from acting as slaves to them, and I proceeded to break the bars of Your yoke and make You walk erect. (Leviticus 26:13)
- And he kept sticking to Yehowah. He did not turn aside from following him, but he continued keeping his commandments that Yehowah had commanded Moses. (2 Kings 18:6)
- I, Yehowah, am your God, the One bringing you up out of the land of Egypt. Open your mouth wide, and I shall fill it. (Psalms 81:10)
