Jeremiah 11:5" For the purpose of carrying out the oath that I swore to your forefathers, to give them the land flowing with milk and honey, as in this day. And I proceeded to answer and say; Amen, O Yehowah.

- On that day Yehowah concluded with Abram a covenant, saying; To your seed I will give this land, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates. (Genesis 15:18)
- And it must occur that, because you continue listening to these judicial decisions and you do keep them and do carry them out, Yehowah your God must keep toward you the covenant and the loving-kindness about which he swore to your forefathers. (Deuteronomy 7:12)
- Which covenant he concluded with Abraham, and his sworn statement to Isaac. (Psalms 105:9)
- And I am proceeding to go down to deliver them out of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up out of that land to a land good and spacious, to a land flowing with milk and honey, to the locality of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. (Exodus 3:8)
- Hence I said to You; You, for Your part, will take possession of their ground, and I, for my part, shall give it to You to take possession of it, a land flowing with milk and honey. Yehowah YOUR God I am, who have divided YOU off from the peoples. (Leviticus 20:24)
- And you must listen, O Israel, and take care to do them, that it may go well with you and that you may become very many, just as Yehowah the God of your forefathers has promised you, as respects the land flowing with milk and honey. (Deuteronomy 6:3)
- For the sons of Israel had walked forty years in the wilderness, until all the nation of the men of war who came out of Egypt that did not listen to the voice of Yehowah had come to its finish, to whom Yehowah swore that he would never let them see the land

that Yehowah had sworn to their forefathers to give to us, a land flowing with milk and honey. (Joshua 5:6)

- To a land flowing with milk and honey, for I shall not go up in the midst of you, because you are a stiff-necked people, that I may not exterminate you on the way. (Exodus 33:3)
- And you must write upon them all the words of this Law when you have crossed, in order that you may enter into the land that Yehowah your God is giving you, a land flowing with milk and honey, according to what Yehowah the God of your forefathers has spoken to you. (Deuteronomy 27:3)
- For the purpose of establishing you today as his people and that he may prove himself your God, just as he has promised you and just as he has sworn to your forefathers Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. (Deuteronomy 29:13)
- At once Benaiah the son of Jehoiada answered the king and said; Amen! Thus may Yehowah the God of my lord the king say. (1 Kings 1:36)
- Yes, Jeremiah the prophet proceeded to say; Amen! Thus may Yehowah do! May Yehowah establish your words that you have prophesied by bringing back the utensils of the house of Yehowah and all the exiled people from Babylon to this place! (Jeremiah 28:6)
- In time you gave them this land that you swore to their forefathers to give to them, a land flowing with milk and honey. (Jeremiah 32:22)
- In that day I lifted up my hand in an oath to them to bring them forth from the land of Egypt to a land that I had spied out for them, one flowing with milk and honey. It was the decoration of all the lands. (Ezekiel 20:6)
