

**Jeremiah 11:5** **For the purpose of carrying out the oath that I swore to YOUR forefathers, to give them the land flowing with milk and honey, as in this day. And I proceeded to answer and say; Amen,<sup>1</sup> O Yehowah.**

- On that day Yehowah concluded with Abram a covenant, saying; To your seed I will **give** this **land**, from the river of Egypt to the great river, the river Euphrates. (**Genesis 15:18**)
- And it must occur that, because **you** continue listening to these judicial decisions and **you** do keep them and do carry them **out**, Yehowah your God must keep toward you the covenant and the loving-kindness about which he **swore** to your **forefathers**. (**Deuteronomy 7:12**)
- Which covenant he concluded with Abraham, and his sworn statement to Isaac. (**Psalms 105:9**)
- And I am proceeding to go down to deliver them **out** of the hand of the Egyptians and to bring them up **out** of that **land** to a **land** good and spacious, to a **land flowing** with **milk** and **honey**, to the locality of the Canaanites and the Hittites and the Amorites and the Perizzites and the Hivites and the Jebusites. (**Exodus 3:8**)
- Hence I said to **you**; **You**, for **your** part, will take possession of their ground, and I, for my part, shall **give** it to **you** to take possession of it, a **land flowing** with **milk** and **honey**. Yehowah **YOUR** God I am, who have divided **you** off from the peoples. (**Leviticus 20:24**)
- And you must listen, O Israel, and take care to do them, that it may go well with you and that **you** may become very many, just as Yehowah the God of your **forefathers** has promised you, as respects the **land flowing** with **milk** and **honey**. (**Deuteronomy 6:3**)
- For the sons of Israel had walked forty years in the wilderness, until all the nation of the men of war who came **out** of Egypt that did not listen to the voice of Yehowah had come to its finish, to whom Yehowah **swore** that he would never let them see the **land**

- that Yehowah had sworn to their **forefathers** to **give** to us, a **land flowing** with **milk** and **honey**. (**Joshua 5:6**)
- To a **land flowing** with **milk** and **honey**, for I shall not go up in the midst of you, because you are a stiff-necked people, that I may not exterminate you on the way. (**Exodus 33:3**)
  - And you must write upon them all the words of this Law when you have crossed, in order that you may enter into the **land** that Yehowah your God is giving you, a **land flowing** with **milk** and **honey**, according to what Yehowah the God of your **forefathers** has spoken to you. (**Deuteronomy 27:3**)
  - For the purpose of establishing you today as his people and that he may prove himself your God, just as he has promised you and just as he has sworn to your **forefathers** Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. (**Deuteronomy 29:13**)
  - At once Benaiah the son of Jehoiada answered the king and said; **Amen!** Thus may Yehowah the God of my lord the king **say**. (**1 Kings 1:36**)
  - Yes, Jeremiah the prophet **proceeded to say; Amen!** Thus may Yehowah do! May Yehowah establish your words that you have prophesied by bringing back the utensils of the house of Yehowah and all the exiled people from Babylon to this place! (**Jeremiah 28:6**)
  - In time you gave them this **land** that you **swore** to their **forefathers** to **give** to them, a **land flowing** with **milk** and **honey**. (**Jeremiah 32:22**)
  - In that day I lifted up my hand in an **oath** to them to bring them forth from the **land** of Egypt to a **land** that I had spied **out** for them, one **flowing** with **milk** and **honey**. It was the decoration of all the **lands**. (**Ezekiel 20:6**)
