Jeremiah 12:15... And it must occur that after my uprooting them I shall again certainly have mercy upon them and will bring them back, each one to his hereditary possession and each one to his land.

- Yehowah your God must also bring back your captives and show you mercy and collect you again from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (Deuteronomy 30:3)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; When I collect together the house of Israel out from the peoples among whom they have been scattered, I will also be sanctified among them in the eyes of the nations. And they will certainly dwell upon their soil that I gave to my servant, to Jacob. (Ezekiel 28:25)
- Until Yehowah gives Your brothers rest, as well as You, and they also have taken possession of the land that Yehowah Your God is giving them across the Jordan, after which You must come back, each one to his holding that I have given You. (Deuteronomy 3:20)
- Here I am collecting them together out of all the lands to which I shall have dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I will bring them back to this place and make them dwell in security. (Jeremiah 32:37)
- And the sons of Judah and the sons of Israel will certainly be collected together into a unity and will actually set up for themselves one head and go up out of the land, because great will be the day of Jezreel. (Hosea 1:11)
- And I will gather back the captive ones of my people Israel, and they will actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (Amos 9:14)
- At that time I shall bring you people in, even in the time of my collecting you together. For I shall make you people to be a name and a praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I gather back your captive ones before your eyes, Yehowah has said. (Zephaniah 3:20)

- When you will have returned to me and kept my commandments and done them, though your dispersed people should happen to be at the end of the heavens, from there I shall collect them and certainly bring them to the place that I have chosen to have my name reside there. (Nehemiah 1:9)
- And I will set my eye upon them in a good way, and I shall certainly cause them to return to this land. And I will build them up, and I shall not tear down, and I will plant them, and I shall not uproot. (Jeremiah 24:6)
- And you must say to them, This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Return to me, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and I shall return to you, Yehowah of armies has said. (Zechariah 1:3)
