

Jeremiah 12:15 And it must occur that after my uprooting them I shall again certainly have mercy upon them and will bring them back, each one to his hereditary possession and each one to his land.

[10] - References:

- Yehowah your God must also **bring back** your captives and show you **mercy** and collect you **again** from all the peoples where Yehowah your God has scattered you. (**Deuteronomy 30:3**)
- This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; When I collect together the house of Israel out from the peoples among whom they **have** been scattered, I **will** also be sanctified among them in the eyes of the nations. And they **will certainly** dwell upon their soil that I gave to my servant, to Jacob. (**Ezekiel 28:25**)
- Until Yehowah gives **YOUR** brothers rest, as well as **YOU**, and they also **have** taken **possession** of the land that Yehowah **YOUR** God is giving them across the Jordan, **after** which **you** must come **back**, each one to his holding that I **have** given **you**. (**Deuteronomy 3:20**)
- Here I am collecting them together out of all the lands to which I shall **have** dispersed them in my anger and in my rage and in great indignation, and I **will bring** them **back** to this place and make them dwell in security. (**Jeremiah 32:37**)
- And the sons of Judah and the sons of Israel **will certainly** be collected together into a unity and **will** actually set up for themselves one head and go up out of the land, because great **will** be the day of Jezreel. (**Hosea 1:11**)
- And I **will** gather **back** the captive ones of my people Israel, and they **will** actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (**Amos 9:14**)
- At that time I shall **bring you** people in, even in the time of my collecting **you** together. For I shall make **you** people to be a name and a praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I gather **back your** captive ones before **YOUR** eyes, Yehowah has said. (**Zephaniah 3:20**)

- When **you will have** returned to me and kept my commandments and done them, though **your** dispersed people should happen to be at the end of the heavens, from there I shall collect them and **certainly bring** them to the place that I **have** chosen to **have** my name reside there. (**Nehemiah 1:9**)
- And I **will** set my eye upon them in a good way, and I shall **certainly** cause them to return to this land. And I **will** build them up, and I shall not tear down, and I **will** plant them, and I shall not uproot. (**Jeremiah 24:6**)
- And you must say to them, This is what Yehowah of armies has said; Return to me, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, and I shall return to **you**, Yehowah of armies has said. (**Zechariah 1:3**)
