Jeremiah 12:3... And you yourself, O Yehowah, know me well, you see me, and you have examined my heart in union with yourself. Single them out like sheep for the slaughtering, and set them apart¹ for the day of killing.

- You yourself have come to know my sitting down and my rising up. You have considered my thought from far off. (Psalms 139:2)
- I beseech you, O Yehowah, remember, please, how I have walked before you in truthfulness and with a complete heart, and what was good in your eyes I have done. And Hezekiah began to weep profusely. (2 Kings 20:3)
- And I well know, O my God, that you are an examiner of the heart, and that it is in rectitude that you take pleasure. I, for my part, in the uprightness of my heart have voluntarily offered all these things, and now your people who are on hand here I have enjoyed seeing make offerings voluntarily to you. - You have examined my heart, you have made inspection by night you have refined me, you will discover that I have not schemed.

 My mouth will not transgress. (Psalms 17:3)
- Will not God himself search this out? For he is aware of the secrets of the heart. (Psalms 44:21)
- But Yehowah of armies is judging with righteousness, he is examining the kidneys and the heart. O may I see your vengeance on them, for it is to you that I have revealed my case at Law. (Jeremiah 11:20)
- But for your sake we have been killed all day long, we have been accounted as sheep for slaughtering. (Psalms 44:22)
- Divine One, God, Yehowah, Divine One, God, Yehowah, he is knowing, and Israel, he too will know. If it is in rebellion and if it is in unfaithfulness against Yehowah, do not save us this day. (Joshua 22:22)

- For Yehowah is taking knowledge of the way of righteous ones, but the very way of wicked ones will perish. (Psalms 1:6)
- In union with God I shall praise his word, in union with Yehowah I shall praise his word. (Psalms 56:10)
- O Yehowah, you have searched through me, and you know me. (Psalms 139:1)
- You yourself have known. O Yehowah, remember me and turn your attention to me and avenge me upon my persecutors. In your slowness to anger do not take me away. Take note of my bearing reproach on account of your own self. (Jeremiah 15:15)
- Therefore give their sons over to the famine, and deliver them over to the power of the sword, and may their wives become women bereaved of children, and widows. And may their own men become those killed with deadly plague, their young men those struck down with the sword in the battle. (Jeremiah 18:21)
- You have lived in luxury upon the earth and have gone in for sensual pleasure. You have fattened Your hearts on the day of slaughter. (James 5:5)
