- Then Joshua said to Achan; My son, render, please, **glory** to **Yehowah** the **God** of Israel and **make** confession to him, and tell me, please, What have you done? Do not hide it from me. (**Joshua 7:19**)
- Ascribe to **Yehowah**, O **you** families of the peoples, ascribe to **Yehowah glory** and strength. (**Psalms 96:7**)
- And they **will** growl over it in that day as with the growling of the sea. And one **will actually** gaze at the land, and, look! There is distressing **darkness**, and even the **light** has grown dark because of the drops falling on it. (**Isaiah 5:30**)
- And to the earth he **will** look, and, lo! Distress and **darkness**, obscurity, hard times and gloominess with no brightness. (**Isaiah 8:22**)
- And it must occur in that day, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, that I **will make** the sun go down at high noon, and I **will** cause **darkness** for the land on a bright day. (**Amos 8:9**)
- The way of the wicked ones is like the **gloom**, they have not known at what they keep stumbling. (**Proverbs 4:19**)
- That is why justice has come to be far away from us, and righteousness does not catch up with us. We keep hoping for **light**, but, look! **Darkness**, for brightness, but in continuous **gloom** we kept walking. (**Isaiah 59:9**)
- For you have crushed us in the place of jackals, and you cover us over with **deep shadow**. (**Psalms 44:19**)
- For, look! Darkness itself **will** cover the earth, and **thick gloom** the national groups, but upon you **Yehowah will** shine forth, and upon you his own **glory will** be seen. (**Isaiah 60:2**)

- My very path he has blocked with a stone wall, and I cannot pass over, and upon my roadways he puts **darkness** itself. (**Job 19:8**)
- Therefore their way **will** become for them like slippery places in the **gloom**, into which they **will** be pushed and **certainly** fall. For I shall bring upon them a calamity, the year of their being given attention, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 23:12**)
- It is I whom he has led and **makes** to walk in **darkness** and not in **light**. (**Lamentations 3:2**)
- It is a day of **darkness** and gloominess, a day of clouds and **thick gloom**, like **light** of dawn spread out upon the **mountains**. There is a people numerous and mighty, one like it has not been made to exist from the indefinite past, and after it there **will** be none again to the years of generation after generation. (**Joel 2:2**)
- For, look! The Former of the **mountains** and the Creator of the wind, and the One telling to earthling man what his mental concern is, the One making dawn into obscurity, and the One treading on earth's high places, **Yehowah** the **God** of armies is his name. (**Amos 4:13**)
- Therefore **you** men **will** have night, so that there **will** be no vision, and **darkness you will** have, so as not to practice divination. And the sun **will certainly** set upon the prophets, and the day must get dark upon them. (**Micah 3:6**)
- And by the flood that is passing along he **will make** an outright extermination of her place, and **darkness will** pursue his very enemies. (**Nahum 1:8**)
- If **you will** not listen, and if **you will** not lay it to heart to give **glory** to my name, **Yehowah** of armies has said; I shall also **certainly** send upon **you** the curse, and I **will** curse **YOUR** blessings. Yes, I have even cursed the blessing, because **you** are not laying it to heart. (**Malachi 2:2**)
- Jesus therefore said to them; The **light will** be among **you** a little while longer. Walk while **you** have the **light**, so that **darkness** does not overpower **you**, and he that walks in the **darkness** does not know where he is going. (**John 12:35**)
