

Jeremiah 14:16 And the very people to whom they are prophesying will become people cast out into the streets of Jerusalem because of the famine and the sword, with no one to do the burying of them, them, their wives and their sons and their daughters. And I will pour out upon them their calamity.

[5] - References:

- They have poured out their blood like water all around Jerusalem, and there is no one to do the burying. (**Psalms 79:3**)
- Speak; This is what the utterance of **Yehowah** is; The dead bodies of mankind must also fall like manure upon the face of the field and like a row of newly cut grain after the reaper, with no one to do the gathering up. (**Jeremiah 9:22**)
- So they **will** eat from the fruitage of their way, and they **will** be gluttoned with their own counsels. (**Proverbs 1:31**)
- Your way and your dealings, there **will** be a rendering of these to you. This is the calamity upon you, for it is bitter, because it **has** reached clear to your heart. (**Jeremiah 4:18**)
- And they **will** have to bear their error. The error of the inquirer **will** prove to be just the same as the error of the prophet. (**Ezekiel 14:10**)
