Jeremiah 14:21" Do not disrespect us for the sake of your name, do not despise your glorious throne. Remember, do not break your covenant with us.

[14] - References:

- Therefore say to the house of Israel; This is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Not for YOUR sakes am I doing it, O house of Israel, but for my holy name, which YOU have profaned among the nations where YOU have come in. (Ezekiel 36:22)
- And now, O Yehowah our God, you who brought your people out from the land of Egypt by a strong hand and proceeded to make a name for yourself as at this day, we have sinned, we have acted wickedly. (Daniel 9:15)
- There is the glorious throne on high from the start, it is the place of our sanctuary. (Jeremiah 17:12)
- Remember Abraham, Isaac and Israel your servants, to whom you swore by yourself, in that you said to them, I shall multiply YOUR seed like the stars of the heavens, and all this land that I have designated I shall give to YOUR seed, that they may indeed take possession of it to time indefinite. (Exodus 32:13)
- And I shall indeed remember my covenant with Jacob, and even my covenant with Isaac and even my covenant with Abraham I shall remember, and the land I shall remember. (Leviticus 26:42)
- And he would remember concerning them his covenant, and he would feel regret according to the abundance of his grand loving-kindness. (Psalms 106:45)
- To perform the mercy in connection with our forefathers and to call to mind his holy covenant. (Luke 1:72)
- And I shall certainly put my tabernacle in the midst of You, and my soul will not abhor You. (Leviticus 26:11)
- And yet for all this, while they continue in the land of their enemies, I shall certainly not reject them nor abhor them so as to exterminate them, to violate my covenant with them, for I am Yehowah their God. (Leviticus 26:44)

- For Yehowah will not desert his people for the sake of his great name, because Yehowah has taken it upon himself to make YOU his people. (1 Samuel 12:22)
- I shall not profane my covenant, and the expression out of my lips I shall not change. (Psalms 89:34)
- In that time they will call Jerusalem the throne of Yehowah, and to her all the nations must be brought together to the name of Yehowah at Jerusalem, and they will no more walk after the stubbornness of their bad heart. (Jeremiah 3:17)
- See, O Yehowah, and do look to the one to whom you have dealt severely in this manner. Should the women keep eating their own fruitage, the children born fully formed, or in the sanctuary of Yehowah should priest and prophet be killed? (Lamentations 2:20)
- So I took my staff Pleasantness and cut it to pieces, in order to break my covenant that I had concluded with all the peoples. (Zechariah 11:10)
