

Jeremiah 14:7[•] Even if our own errors do testify against us, O Yehowah, act for the sake of your name, for our acts of unfaithfulness have become many, it is against you that we have sinned.

- And the Canaanites and all the inhabitants of the land will hear of it, and they will certainly surround us and cut our **name** off from the earth, and what will you do for your great name? (**Joshua 7:9**)
- For your name's **sake**, O **Yehowah**, you must even forgive my error, for it is considerable. (**Psalms 25:11**)
- To us belongs nothing, O **Yehowah**, to us belongs nothing, but to your **name** give glory according to your loving-kindness, according to your trueness. (**Psalms 115:1**)
- And I went on to say; O my God, I do feel ashamed and embarrassed to raise my face to you, O my God, for our **errors** themselves **have** multiplied over our head and our guiltiness has grown great even to the heavens. (**Ezra 9:6**)
- And you are righteous as regards all that has come upon us, for faithfully is how you **have** acted, but we are the ones that **have** done wickedly. (**Nehemiah 9:33**)
- That is why a lion out of the forest has struck them, a wolf itself of the desert plains keeps despoiling them, a leopard is keeping awake at their cities. Everyone going forth from them gets torn to pieces. For their transgressions **have become many**, their **acts of unfaithfulness have become** numerous. (**Jeremiah 5:6**)
- We **have sinned** and done wrong and acted wickedly and rebelled, and there has been a turning aside from your commandments and from your judicial decisions. (**Daniel 9:5**)
- O **Yehowah**, to us belongs the shame of face, to our kings, to our princes and to our forefathers, because we **have sinned against** you. (**Daniel 9:8**)
- For you are my crag and my stronghold, and for the **sake** of your **name** you will lead me and conduct me. (**Psalms 31:3**)

- Help us, O God of our salvation, for the **sake** of the glory of your **name**, and deliver us and cover over our sins on account of your **name**. (**Psalms 79:9**)
- For the **sake** of my **name** I shall check my anger, and for my praise I shall restrain myself toward you that there may be no cutting you off. (**Isaiah 48:9**)
- For our revolts **have become many** in front of you, and as for our sins, each one has testified **against** us. For our revolts are with us, and as for our **errors**, we well know them. (**Isaiah 59:12**)
- And I drew back my hand and went acting for the **sake** of my **own name**, that it should not be profaned before the eyes of the nations, before whose eyes I had brought them out. (**Ezekiel 20:22**)
- Incline your ear, O my God, and hear. Do open your eyes and see our desolated conditions and the city that has been called by your **name**, for not according to our righteous **acts** are we letting our entreaties fall before you, but according to your **many** mercies. (**Daniel 9:18**)
- And it occurred that when it had finished eating up the vegetation of the land, I proceeded to say; O Sovereign Lord **Yehowah**, forgive, please. Who will rise up of Jacob? For he is small! (**Amos 7:2**)
