

Jeremiah 15:1 And Yehowah proceeded to say to me; **If Moses and Samuel were standing before me, my soul would not be toward this people. There would be a sending of them away from before my face, that they might go out.**

- And **Moses** proceeded to soften the **face** of Yehowah his God and to **say**; Why, O Yehowah, should your anger blaze against your **people** whom you brought **out** of the land of Egypt with great power and with a strong hand? (**Exodus 32:11**)
- Then **Samuel** took a sucking lamb and offered it up as a burnt offering, a whole offering, to Yehowah, and **Samuel** began calling to Yehowah for aid in behalf of Israel, and Yehowah **proceeded** to answer him. (**1 Samuel 7:9**)
- **Moses** and Aaron were among his priests, and **Samuel** was among those calling upon his name. They were calling to Yehowah, and he himself kept answering them. (**Psalms 99:6**)
- And he was about to **say** to annihilate them, if it had not been for **Moses** his chosen one, who stood in the gap **before** him, to turn back his rage from bringing them to ruin. (**Psalms 106:23**)
- Consequently Yehowah rejected all the seed of Israel and kept afflicting them and giving them into the hand of pillagers, until he had cast them **away** from **before** him. (**2 Kings 17:20**)
- And I will throw **you out** from **before** my **face**, just as I threw **out** all **YOUR** brothers, the whole offspring of Ephraim. (**Jeremiah 7:15**)
- Then Abraham approached and began to **say**; Will you really sweep **away** the righteous with the wicked? (**Genesis 18:23**)
- However, Yehowah said to **Moses**; Whoever has sinned against me, I shall wipe him **out** of my book. (**Exodus 32:33**)
- Therefore Yehowah got very incensed against Israel, so that he removed them from his sight. He did not let any remain but the tribe of Judah alone. (**2 Kings 17:18**)

- **And also for the innocent blood that he had shed, so that he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, and Yehowah did not consent to grant forgiveness. (2 Kings 24:4)**
- **And in my ears Yehowah of armies has revealed himself; This error will not be atoned for in **YOUR** behalf until **you people** die, the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies, has said. (Isaiah 22:14)**
- **And as for you, do not pray in behalf of this **people**, neither raise in their behalf an entreating cry or a prayer nor beseech me, for I shall not be listening to you. (Jeremiah 7:16)**
- **And had these three men proved to be in the midst of it, Noah, Daniel and Job, they themselves because of their righteousness would deliver their soul, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (Ezekiel 14:14)**
